The MCCPL recognizes the web as a 24/7 medium, and your comments are welcome at any time. In an effort to better manage our staff resources (your tax dollars), the MCCPL only monitor comments and postings during regular business hours.

If a concern or issue is addressed that we cannot answer, we will make sure the concern is directed to the appropriate individual.

Once posted, the MCCPL reserves the right to delete submissions that contain:

- 1. Vulgar language
- 2. Personal attacks of any kind
- 3. Comments or content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, age, religion, gender, marital status, genetics, status with regard to public assistance, national origin, physical or intellectual disability or sexual orientation
- 4. Spam or links to other sites
- 5. Clearly off topic
- 6. Advocate illegal activity
- 7. Promote particular services, products, or political organizations
- 8. Infringe on copyrights or trademarks
- 9. Personally identifiable information that would infringe upon an individual's privacy.
- 10. Information that may compromise the safety, security or proceedings of public systems or any criminal or civil investigations.
