Great News! "Grab and Go" Service Now Available!

Hello,

We are happy to announce that we have reopened for **limited walk-in service**. We will be operating at 25% capacity, allowing only brief, purposeful visits. Virtual programs, online services and resources and Wi-Fi from our parking lot continue to be available for you to use.

- You may enter the building for short visits (**30 minutes or less**) to find and check out materials. Small groups of **no more than two people or one parent with two children** are strongly encouraged. Members not of the same household must remain **6 ft.** apart.
- **Curbside delivery service will continue during the same hours of operation.** Request materials online or by phone. When notified your request is available, call the library to set up an appointment for contactless curbside delivery.
- **Face masks are mandatory** for everyone except children under 2 (EO 2020-147). **If you don't feel comfortable wearing one we encourage you to use our Curbside Delivery.**
- Most seating has been removed. **Priority seating** is reserved for seniors or guests with disabilities or mobility issues.
- Our public computers and our copy service are not yet available.
- Browsing in the stacks is limited to **2 people per aisle** with a **6 ft. space** between them at all times. Please self-monitor and respect directions on signs. Please use the **carts provided** for replacing unwanted items, rather than reshelving them, and if possible use our **self-check stations** for checkout.
- For the safety of the community, do not enter the Library with symptoms of an infectious disease. **Per [CDC guidelines](#)**, if you have an illness such as the flu you cannot enter the Library until at least **twenty-four (24) hours** after you are free of **fever of 100.4 degrees F** or greater, without fever-reducing medications.

- Public safety measures are posted on the front entrance doors. **As you enter the building, please use the provided hand sanitizer.**
- To minimize cross contamination **please return materials to the drive up book return or the lobby book return. Staff cannot accept returns at the front desk.** After a **72 hour quarantine**, materials will be checked in and removed from your account .
- Whitelakelibrary.org is always open with 24/7 access to books, movies, magazines, music and more.
