**Children's/YA Librarian Report:**

In June, youth services continued providing an established slate of digital programming, including yoga for kids, STEM videos, and virtual storytimes. Summer reading began at the very end of June. We're using Beanstack, specialized reading program software, thanks to a two-year software grant from MBLC. On the last day of June, Storytime With a Princess (featuring Princess Snow) kicked off our summer programming, which will continue through July and the first half of August.

Our grant proposal for Virtual Programming for Distance Learning has been selected for funding by the MBLC in the amount of \$3,038.00. This funding will cover costs for a wide array of distance learning projects, from a story walk (for which we plan to partner with Medway Parks and Rec), PLA filament for our 3D printer, camera equipment to film tutorials and make movies, a gaming console to provide another virtual point of contact in our future Animal Crossing island, graphic design software, and an array of materials for make-and-take kits we'll partner with Zoom programs.
