



How to connect to EBSCO

1. Have your Durham Public Library card ready
2. Open a web browser
3. Connect to www.durhampubliclibrary.org
4. Hover over 'Library Services & Resources' along the top of the page
5. Click 'Research & Databases'
6. Scroll down to the EBSCO and other Free Online Databases
 - a. EBSCO offers: Consumer Reports, Explora for articles and journals, Consumer Health Complete, Academic Search Premier, NoveList and more!
 - b. You can read a summary of what each service EBSCO offers on this page
7. To use these databases, click the **link or button 'EBSCO Host'**
8. On the EBSCO Login page enter **your Durham Public Library card number**
9. You will now see links to all the EBSCO databases!
