Qualifications

- Must be willing to commit a minimum of 1 hour per quarter on average to start and any other time members choose to devote to program planning, book suggestions and reviews, and other TAB activities or volunteer services throughout the year.
- Membership occurs/recurs on a yearly basis from the time the application is approved
- Must be willing to respect the opinions of others

Benefits of Serving on TAB

- Granted Community Service hours for National Honor Society, Scouts, etc.
- Involvement may be included on college applications or job resumes
- Reference letter for college and job applications upon request

- Brainstorming and helping to plan teen programs
