This month we talked to Penny St. Cyr about her volunteer work at the library.

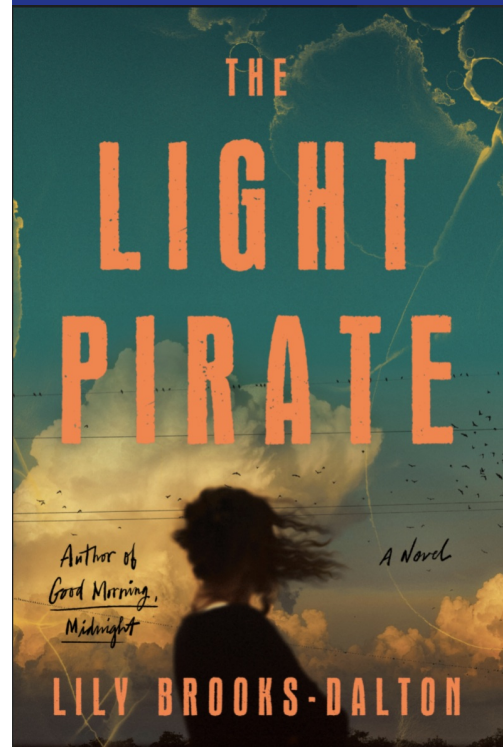
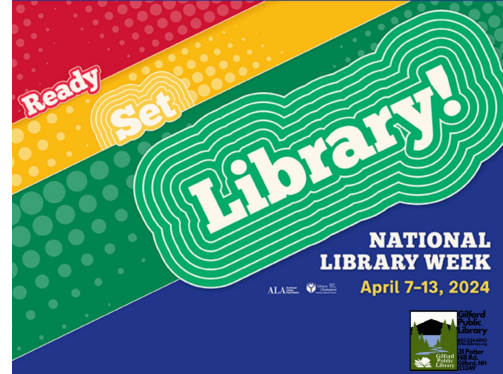
