## Online Newspapers

The database “Massachusetts Libraries” listed on our home page links to NewsBank, which offers articles from the past 20 years from MA newspapers as well as copies of national magazines. It is also in the list of Research Databases.

A library card is required to access the platform online.

Results can be narrowed as much as you would like. Options include: date, state of publication, and publisher. If title or subject of interest is the basis of the search, users can add as many search bars as necessary.



The order of results can also be changed, so more applicable result will be listed higher.



After finding an article of interest to you, results can be saved as a pdf, added to a collection in your account, or shared via email. Options are listed in the bar at the top of the page.



## **Print Newspapers**

The library also offers print newspapers for use in the library. Current issues for that day are kept behind the circulation desk and are available upon request.

The library keeps up to 2 weeks of back issues in the Judy Williams Reading Room next to the historic Southborough Villager collection.
