Cristina Ashjian is an art and architectural historian based in Moultonborough, where she is the Chair of the Moultonborough Heritage Commission. With an MA from the Courtauld Institute of Art, University of London, and a PhD from Northwestern University, Cristina lectures statewide on NH's country estate movement for NH Humanities. In Moultonborough, she has served on steering committees for the Town's Master Plan, two Plan New Hampshire charrettes, and the UNH First Impressions assessment focused on Moultonborough Village. Cristina was also recognized with LRPC's Community Service Award in 2019. Early in 2021, the Moultonborough Select Board appointed her to serve as its Commissioner on the Lakes Region Planning Commission and she was subsequently elected to the Executive Board at its annual meeting in 2022.
