
At the regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen, Gordon M. Huckins, Chairman, made the motion to establish the following Dog Ordinance:


By vote of the Town of New Hampton at the annual town meeting on March 4, 1975 authorizing the Selectmen to adopt an ordinance for the restraint or control of dogs in the New Hampton Precinct the following regulations are adopted.


It shall be unlawful to allow any dog or dogs owned or kept in the New Hampton Precinct, when within the limits of the said Precinct and not upon or within the premises or property of its owner or keeper, to run at large.

Penalty: Any owner or keeper of a dog found in violation of this ordinance, may be fined a maximum of twenty-five dollars for each violation thereof, upon complaint before the District Court, and said fine shall be returned to the Town of New Hampton.

Voted in the affirmative unanimously by the Board at 10:10 P.M.
