Most SWQPA rules were scheduled to expire 7/1/2016. Deadline has been extended. DES is proposing to readopt the rules. Amendments will be proposed to clarify existing provisions and to reflect changes made to RSA 483-B between 2009 and 2013, mostly related to Permit by Notification Process.
