Dear Program Administrator,

In a collaborative effort, the towns of Plymouth and Holderness New Hampshire are applying for a Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant to enhance outdoor recreation between the two towns with a sustainable trail network. Both towns will be working together to create what will be a mutually beneficial project, bringing multi-user outdoor recreation to the towns.

If the flood plain forest and oxbow area in Plymouth and Holderness becomes a designated recreation area by the State of New Hampshire's Natural and Cultural Resources Department, then PRLAC agrees that a member of PRLAC shall serve on a supervisory group to oversee the long term management of recreation area. This supervisory group would meet quarterly at first, and at least annually after the development phase is completed. Initial tasks for the group will include creation of a stewardship plan for the proposed area and, as time progresses, modify that plan as situations change.
