Fire Extinguishers

Tom McSherry, Fire Control Services Co., Inc.

Tom will cover the various types of portable fire extinguishers, the basic construction and components of each, and the different extinguishing agents used. He will cover the proper use and disposal of each type, highlight the differences between them, and address any issues or hazards specific to each type. Fire Control Services handles portable fire extinguishers, automatic fire suppression systems, fire alarm and security systems including video monitoring and access control. They currently have 17 employees.

Propane Tanks

Jennifer Heaton-Jones, CT PSC

Jen is the Chair of the CT Product Stewardship Council (PSC). Municipalities in Connecticut are facing significant challenges in managing pressurized gas cylinders, including high disposal costs, explosions in material recovery facilities, and litter in state and local parks. The CT PSC, which represents local governments in Connecticut, introduced an EPR (extended producer responsibility) bill for gas cylinders in 2020 and 2021.

Smoke Detectors

Liza Krass, Veolia North America

Veolia helps safely treat, recycle, and dispose of hazardous and regulated wastes to protect people and the environment. Homeowners have a solution for their chemicals and other dangerous materials to keep them out of local landfills as well as water resources. Liza specializes in the management of radioactive and mixed wastes which can also be found in everyday products at home.

Flares

Julie will outline the considerations for the King County hazardous waste program's decision to accept aerial marine flares. The presentation will talk about research and cost considerations around accepting the flares. Julie will also talk about the difficulties for King County residents and CESQG businesses looking to properly dispose of flares and how their program was able to become a disposal option.
