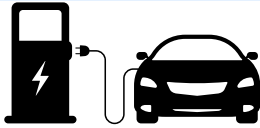

### NEVI Update

NHDOT has allotted around \$17.2 million in funding to the National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) program. NHDOT updated the NEVI Plan and it was approved in September of 2023 and has 9.9 Million in funding approved by Federal Highways Administration (FHWA). The first request for proposal (RFP) is currently out and has a deadline of December 15th, 2023 at 2:00PM. These initial projects will mostly focus on the NH Route 16 and the Interstates.

### Charging and Fueling Infrastructure (CFI) Grant

NHDES has applied for \$10 million in funding from the FHWA CFI to install community EV charging stations in NH. It will be distributed as a statewide competitive subgrant with 80/20 matching funds. The grant has not been awarded and should be announced soon.



### STATEWIDE BIKE/PED PLAN RELEASED



NHDOT has just released the completed 2023 Pedestrian and Bicycle Plan. This document provides recommendations and plans for creating infrastructure that is safe, accessible, and beneficial for non-motorized travel in the state. ### VULNERABLE ROAD USER SAFETY ASSESSMENT AVAILABLE

The Vulnerable Road User Safety Assessment is a tool produced by NHDOT that analyzes the level of vehicle crashes that involve pedestrians and bicyclists. This report provides trending statistics for the state, the contributing factors to these types of crashes, and countermeasures and recommendations. This report is in the final stages, so keep an eye out for its release!
