Status of fire safety projects

The projects are going forward. The sprinkler system requires a separate water line. Alison will speak with Mike Bergeron. She will also seek estimates for the system from Hampshire Fire Protection, Life Safety, and Impact. Possible sources for funds are a warrant article and an L-CHIP grant.

Public meetings in the library

After discussions on safety, it was decided that groups can meet as long as mask and cleaning rules are followed. There will be no use of public restrooms.

Proposed changes to town employee evaluation

The trustees believe that performance must be evaluated in relationship to the job description. Pat, Molly, and Peter will review the library's old wage and salary scale. We will revisit the topic at our September meeting.
