Job Description: Lifeguard

Starting Salary: \$18.00 per hour

Position: Seasonal Part Time

Hours: Sunday-Saturday, 9am-3pm, 16-40 hours per week, flexible days, Tuesday/Friday and weekends required

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Red Cross Lifeguard Training (or equivalent), and CPR for the Professional Rescuer are requirements of the job and a condition of employment
- Criminal Background Check approval is required for applicants 18 years or older, 3 letters of reference for applicants under 18 years of age
- Ability to effectively communicate with the public, and staff
- Work cooperatively and harmoniously with people in an enthusiastic manner
- Knowledge of principles and practices of beach rules, policies, and procedures

Supervision Received: Works under the general supervision of the Parks & Recreation Director who makes work assignments and evaluates performance based on safety procedures and completion of assigned tasks in accordance with instructions.

Supervision Exercised: Patrons as needed

Essential Functions:

- Supervise and enforce swimming rules with regard to safety of patrons
- Maintain order at the beach and take steps to prevent trouble
- Assist Swim Instructor with equipment and supervision of participants as requested
- Check all equipment and supplies and report any repairs or needs to the Recreation Director
- Remove all trash from beach and lower parking lot area upon exit and place in dumpster.
- Responsible for safety and well-being of patrons
- Maintains a friendly and courteous relationship with beach patrons and other employees
- Must be able to work under stressful situations when first aid treatment is required
- Must be able to respond quickly and accurately
- Must be able to work in extreme weather conditions
- Other duties as assigned
