












Recommended for ages 7 & up. Families encouraged.

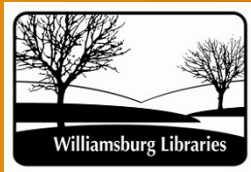
