The issuance of a permit based upon plan specifications, data and other reports shall not prevent the Belmont, NH Fire Department from thereafter requiring correction of deficiencies. Any deficiencies found during field inspection, testing, or Fire Company Surveys shall also be corrected.

The completed installation shall pass a visual inspection and a complete operating test witnessed by a representative of the Belmont Fire Department. Please call at least 48 hours in advance to schedule inspections or tests.

The Fire Suppression System is required to be connected to a Building Fire Alarm System. In accordance with Belmont Fire Department Regulations, no permit-required work will begin prior to the issuance of proper permits and / or approvals by the Belmont Fire Department.

Submittal of plans and payment of fees do not imply permission or permit by the Belmont Fire Department for project design or commencement of work.

The system design shall comply with one or all of the following: UL300 Fire Extinguishing Systems for Protection of Restaurant Cooking Areas, NFPA 17A Wet Chemical Extinguisher Systems, NFPA 96 Installations of Equipment for the Removal of Smoke and Grease Laden Vapors from Commercial Cooking Equipment, NFPA 33 Standard for Spray Application Using Flammable or Combustible Materials and local or state codes and standards.

APPROVED PLANS AND A COPY OF THE PERMIT MUST BE KEPT ON SITE DURING CONSTRUCTION.
