Join us as Ted Reinstein visits the Auburn Public Library to share insights from his newest book *Travels through the Heart and Soul of New England*

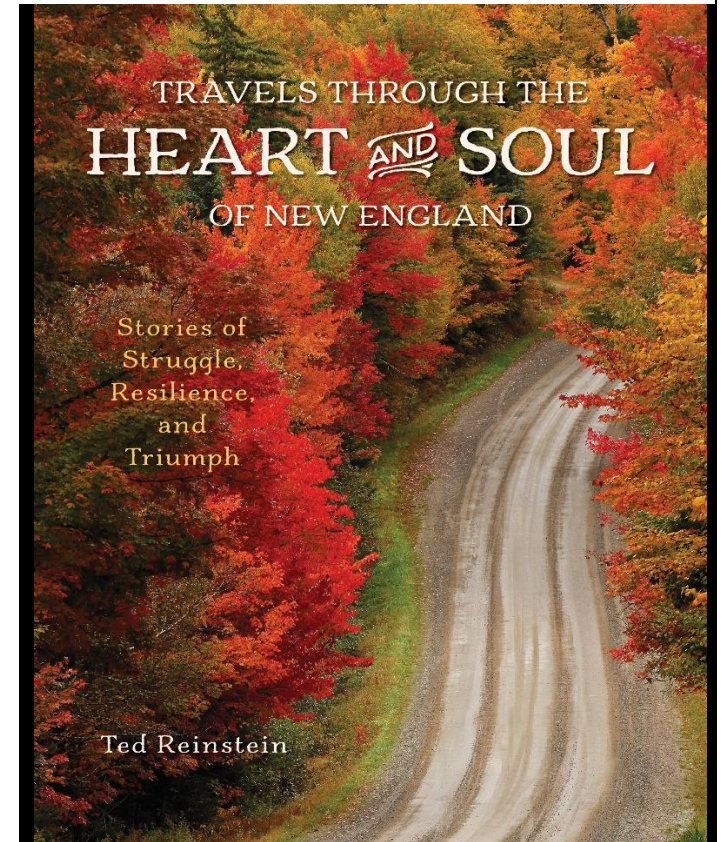
