The Belmont Board of Selectmen will hold two consecutive Public Hearings on Monday, July 6, 2020 beginning at 10:15 a.m. at the Belmont Corner Meeting House, 16 Sargent Street, Belmont, NH. Community Development Block Grant funds are available to municipalities through the NH Community Development Finance Authority. Up to \$500,000 annually is available on a competitive basis for economic development, and public facility and housing projects, up to \$350,000 in emergency activities and up to \$25,000 is available for feasibility study grants. All projects must primarily benefit low- and moderate-income persons.

The subjects of the hearings are as follows:

1. A proposed application to the Community Development Finance Authority for up to \$25,000 in Community Development Block Grant Planning Study funds. The study will be used to examine the historic rehabilitation of the Gale School Building as a public facility. The funds less administration will be sub granted to Laconia Area Community Land Trust d/b/a Lakes Region Community Developers.
2. And the Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan.
