In an effort to maintain Trick or Treat in the safest way possible during the pandemic, the Town of Belmont Board of Selectmen are offering the following safety guidelines:

We encourage families and residents to make the best decision for themselves and what is safest for their families. If you do not wish to have your home participate in giving out treats, you may simply dim or shut your lights off and consider including a sign if you wish stating that you are not participating.

Homes who are participating in Trick or Treat should.....

- Only give out wrapped items
- Consider giving out items outside, on a table, keeping 6-foot distance, or behind a storm door and replace treats before each visitor or group
- Not hand treats to children directly
- Put out hand sanitizer, and wear a mask when handing out candy

Trick or Treaters who are participating should.....

- Trick or Treat in small groups, preferably with family members only, and within your own neighborhood
- Avoid large groups and going inside any homes
- Carry hand sanitizer, gloves are not recommended
- Wear protective masks (this may be part of a costume if cloth)
- Wait until parents can check over candy before eating

Please be considerate and understanding to those wishing not to hand out candy. They are choosing what is safest for them .
