Vendors are welcome to set up tents/tables on Friday night, however this is at the vendor's own risk. The day will end with the annual Chicken BBQ held at the Belmont Fire Department at 4:30pm.

All vendors will receive a confirmation email when application is received. Parking in town is very limited. You will receive a vendor map along with any additional information by August 3rd. While we will do our best to put you in requested spots, spots are not guaranteed.
