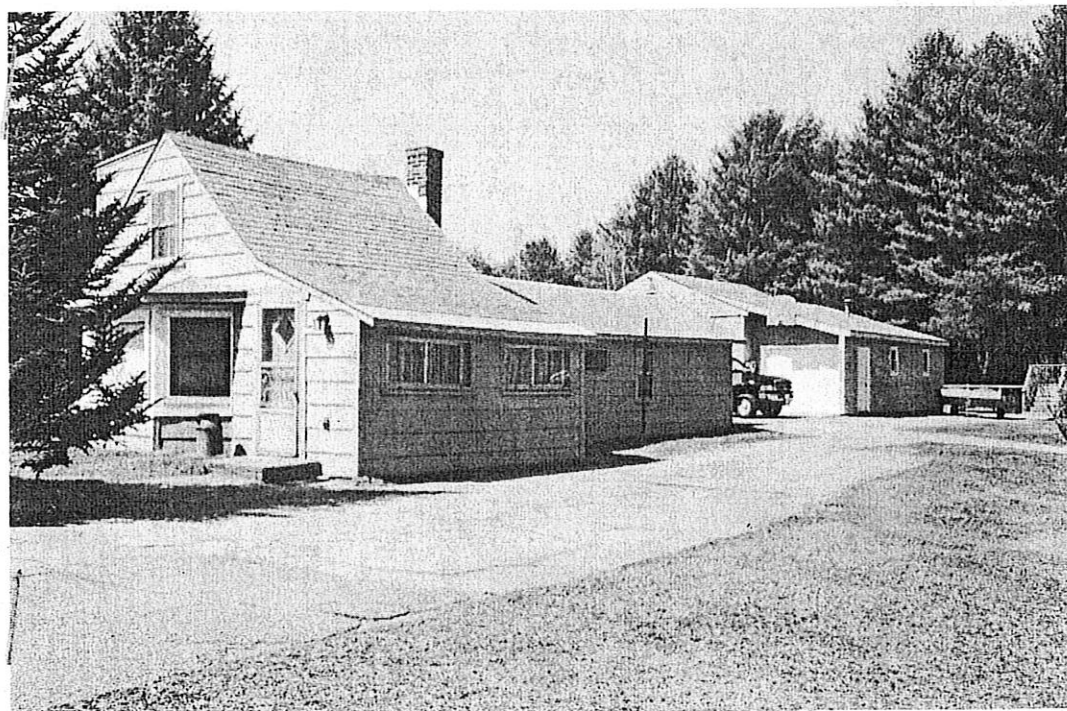


Photo 2 description: East elevation of house & garage

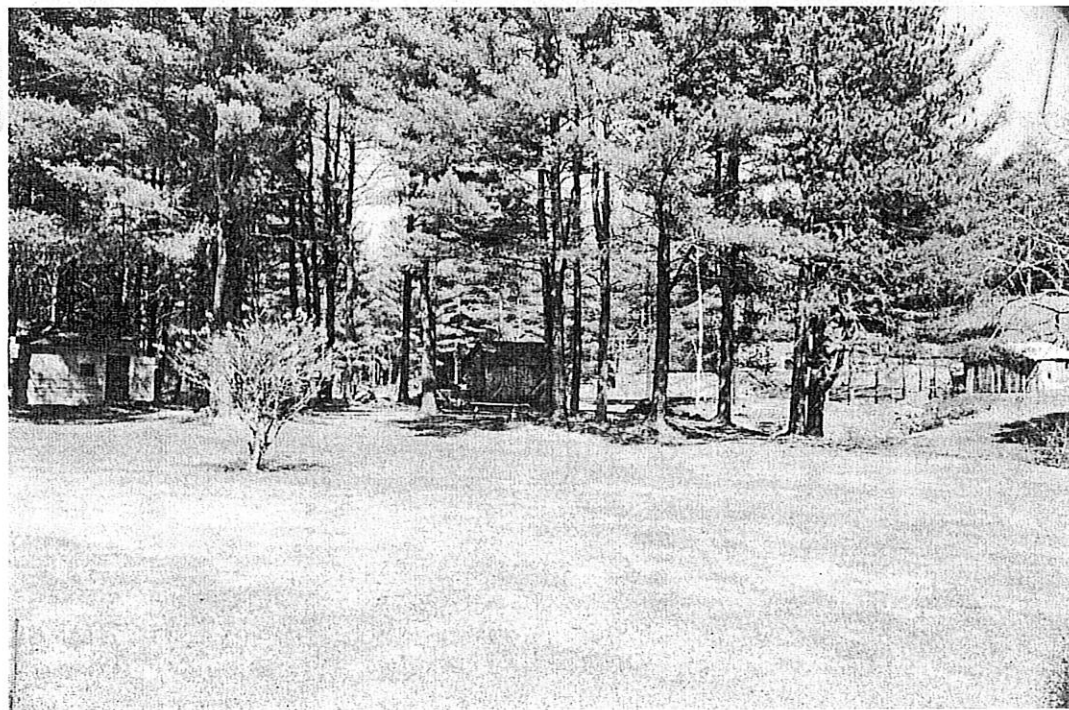


Photo 3 description: View of outbuildings & pasture in upper right

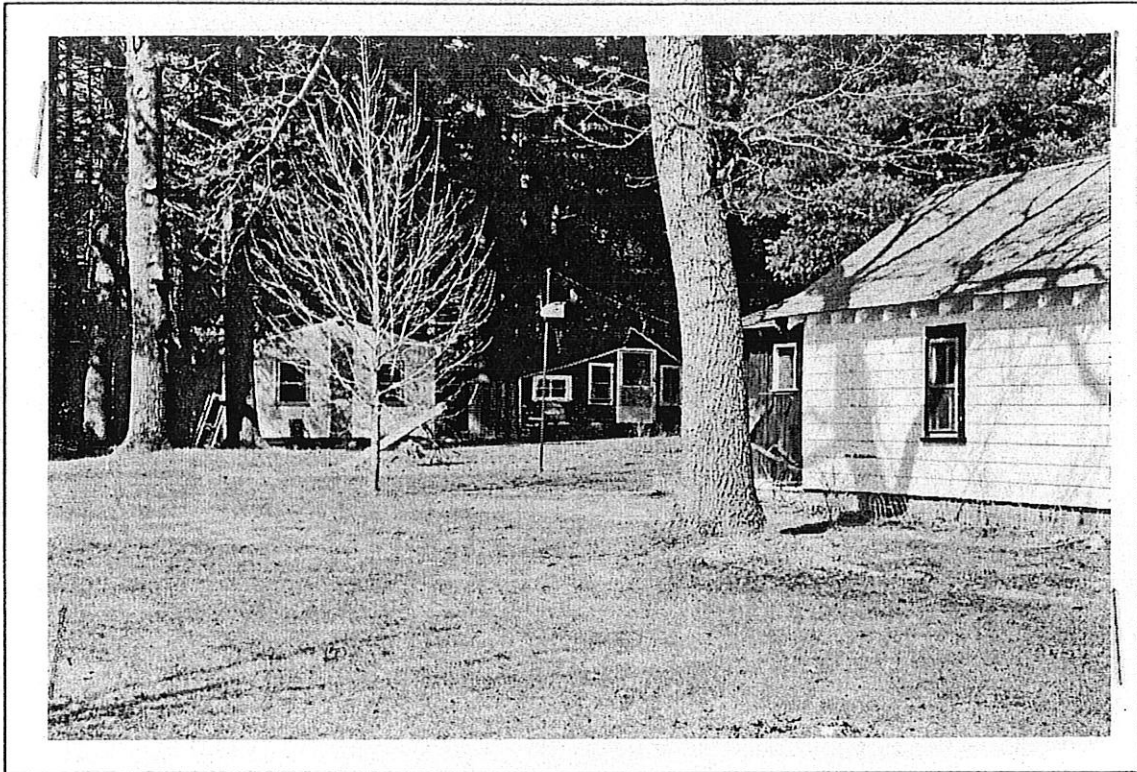


Photo 2 description: Garage (far right) & sheds (background)

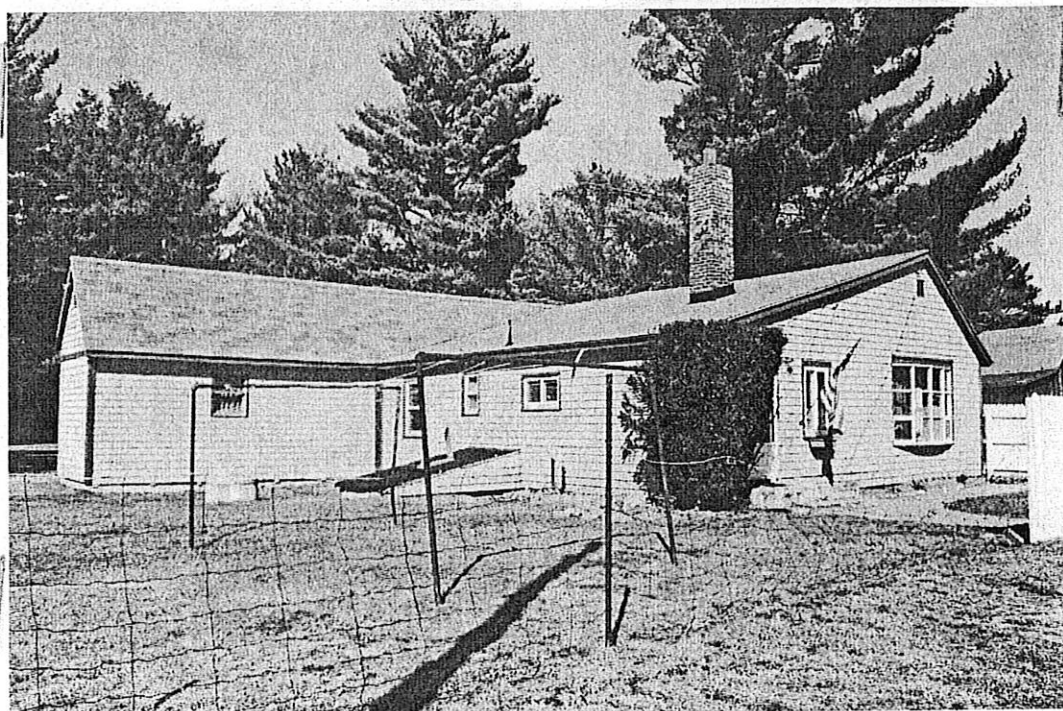


Photo 2 description: View of property from road

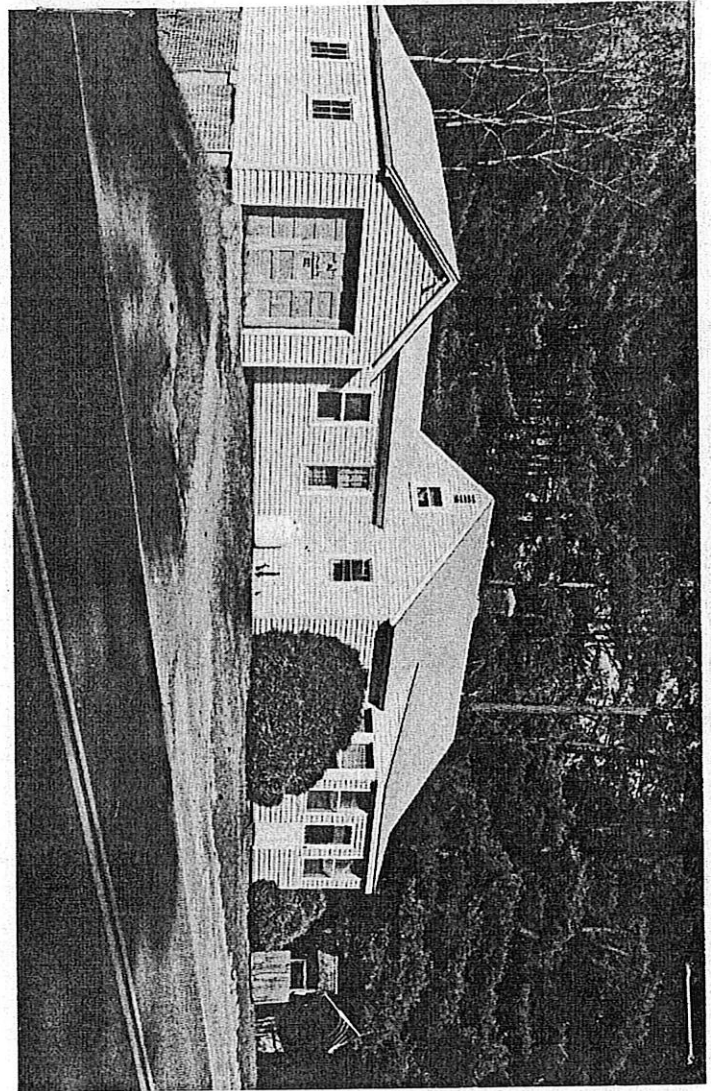

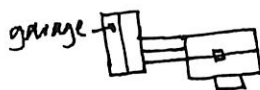

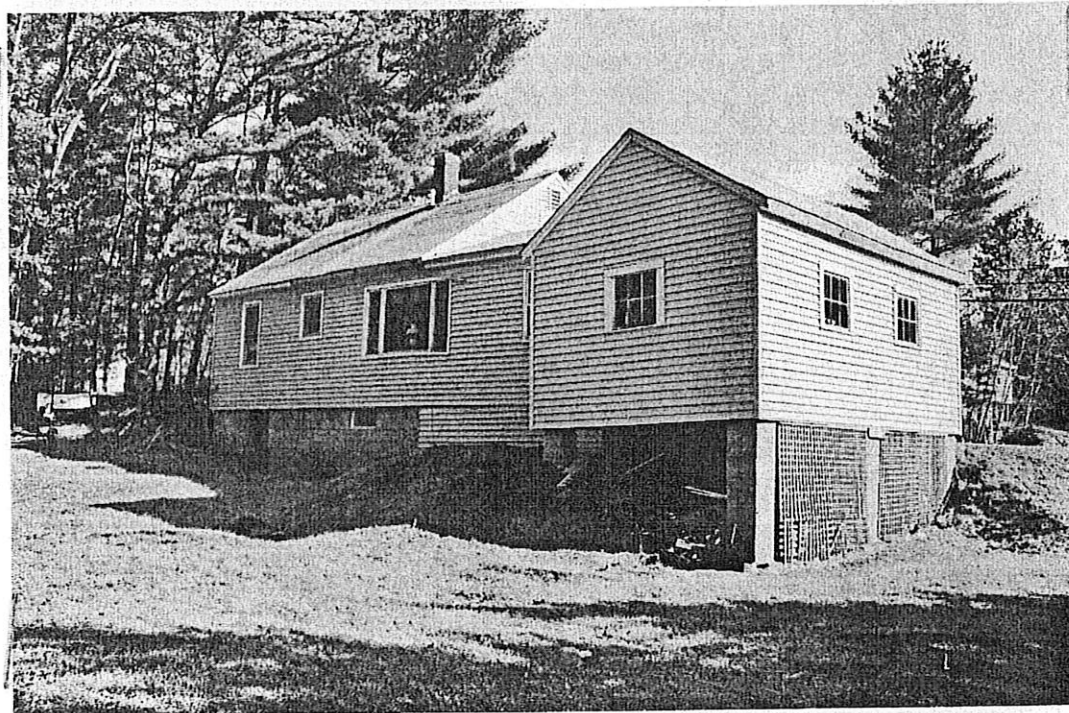


Photo 2 description: Rear of house, wing & garage

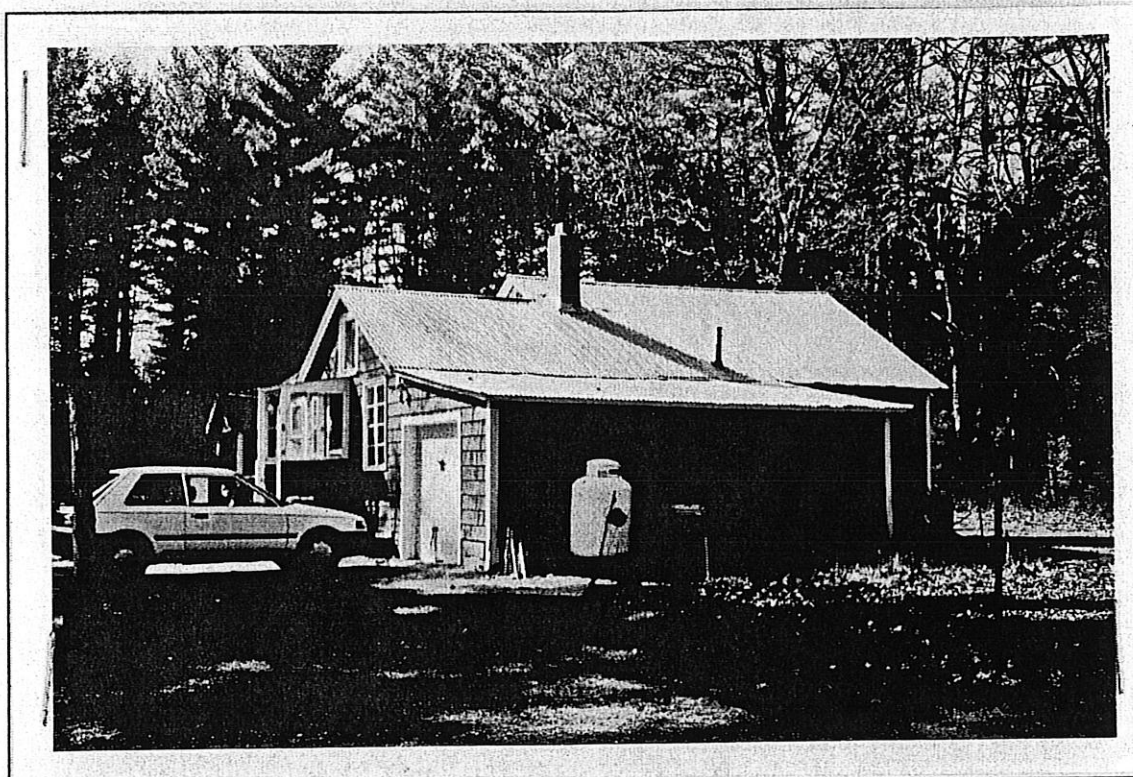


Photo 2 description: East elevation of house and later garage addition

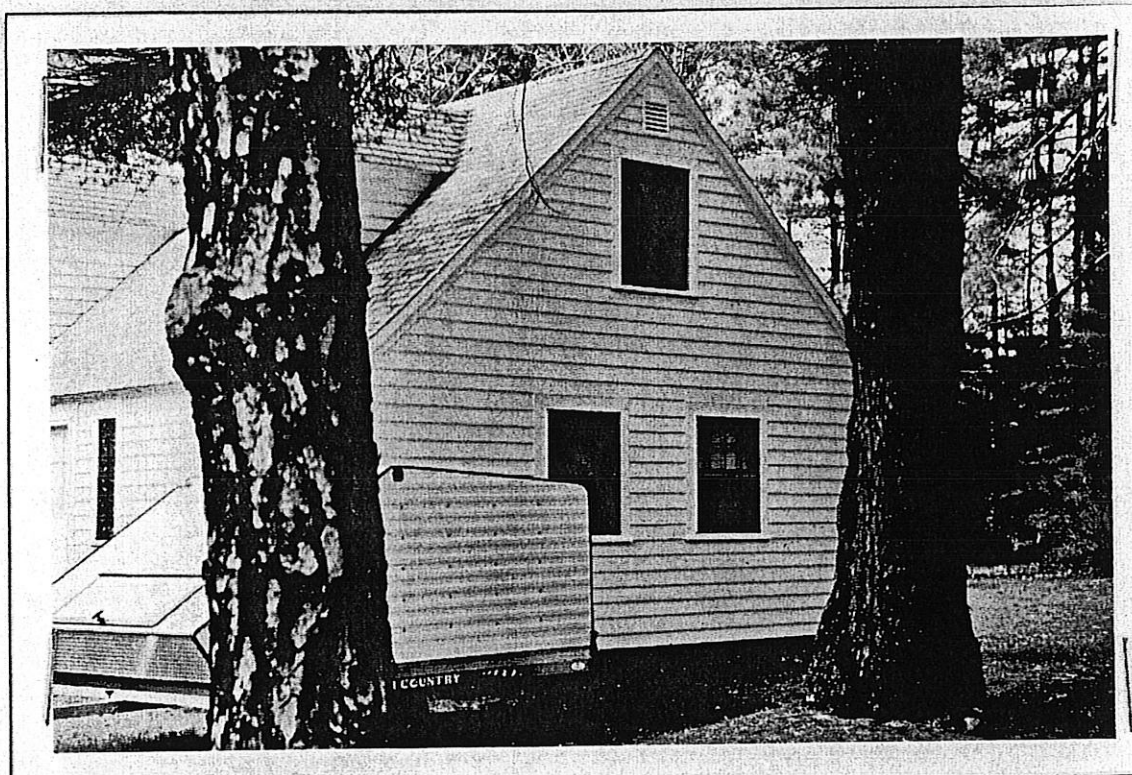


Photo 2 description: East elevation

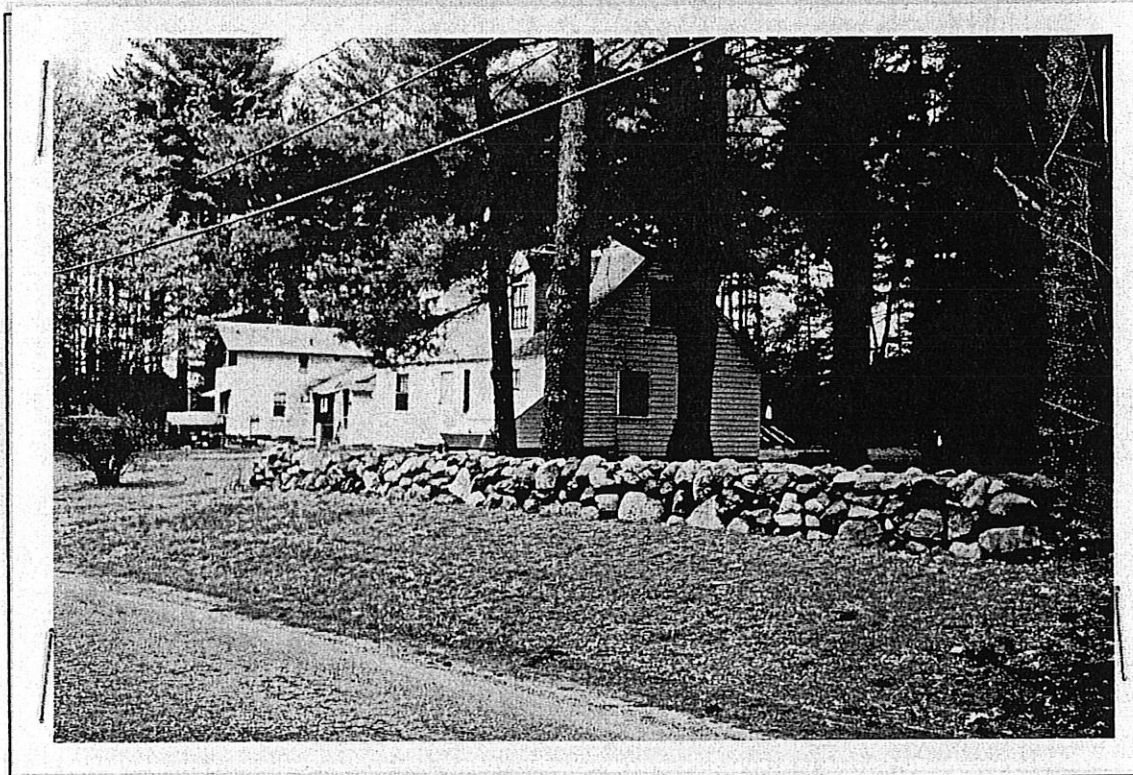


Photo 4 description: View of house from road, showing stone wall

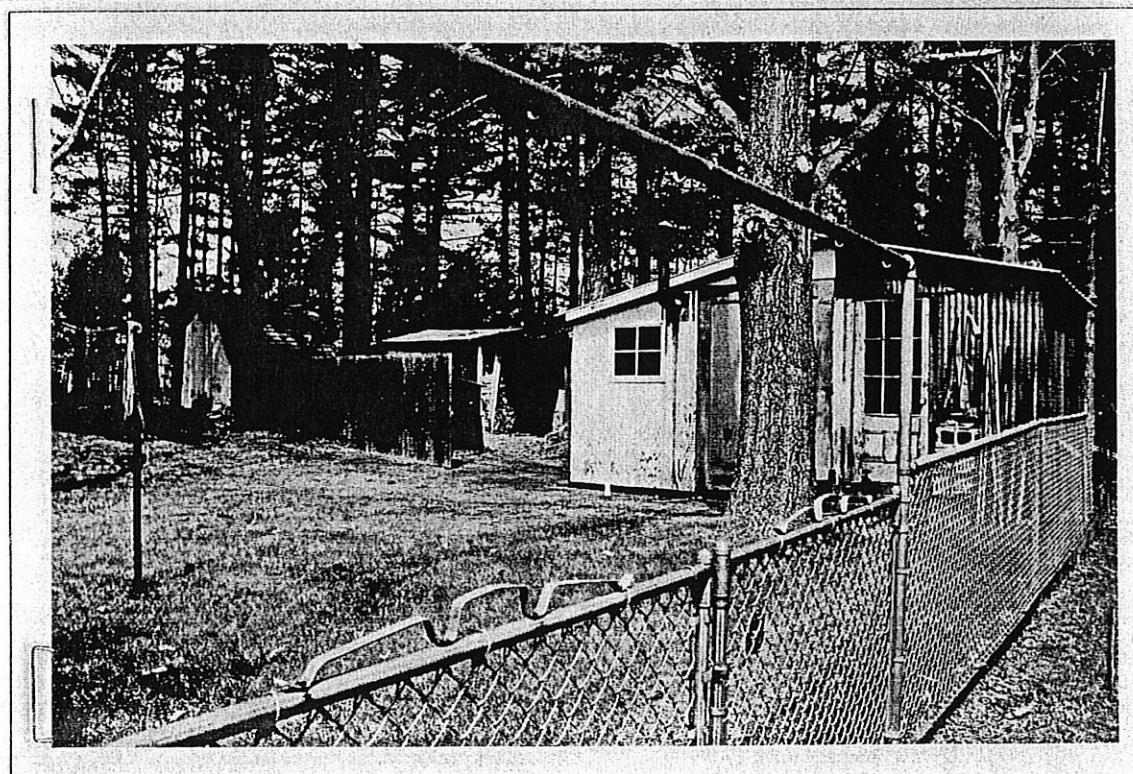


Photo 3 description: Sheds behind house

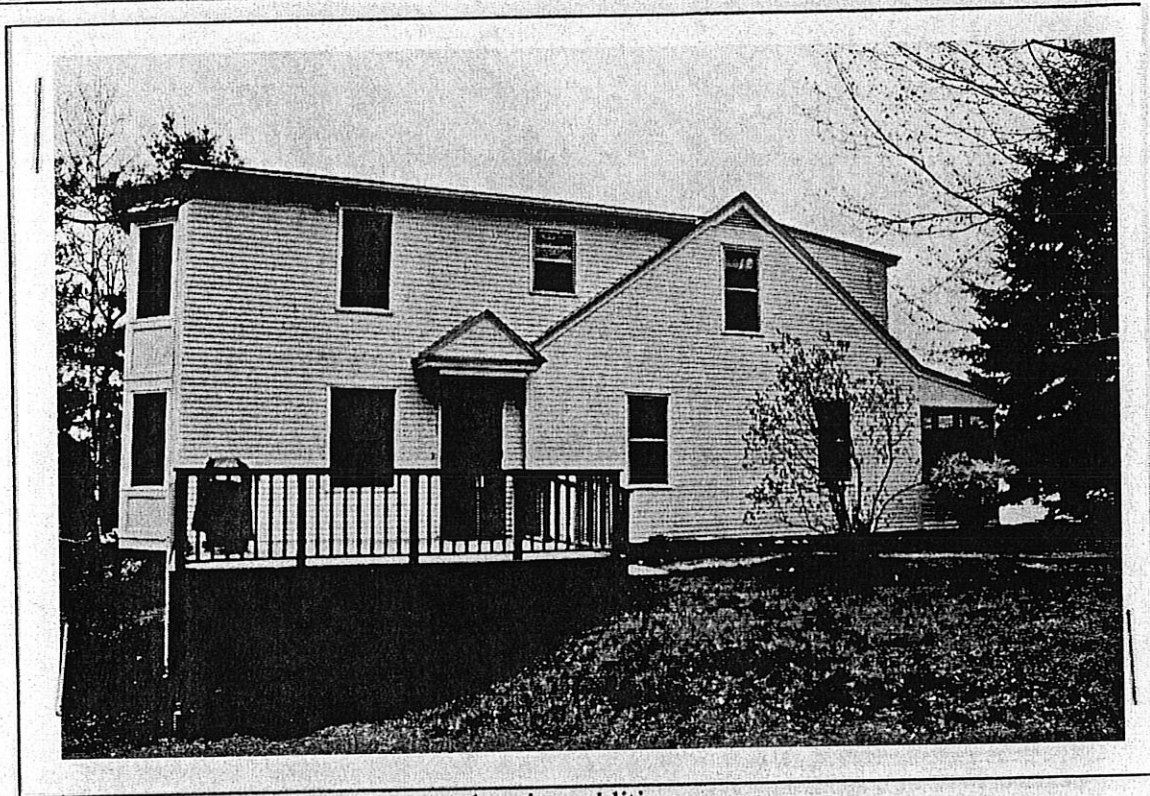


Photo 2 description: East elevation of house, showing addition

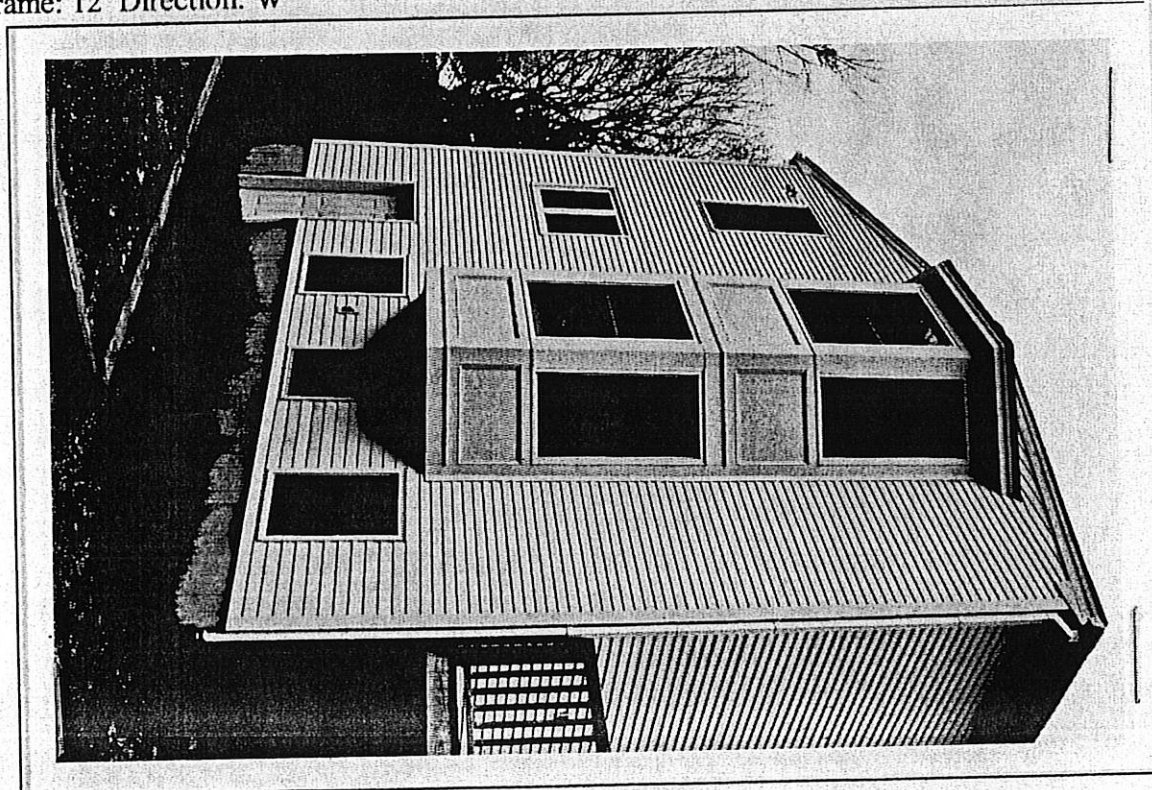


Photo 3 description: Rear of addition

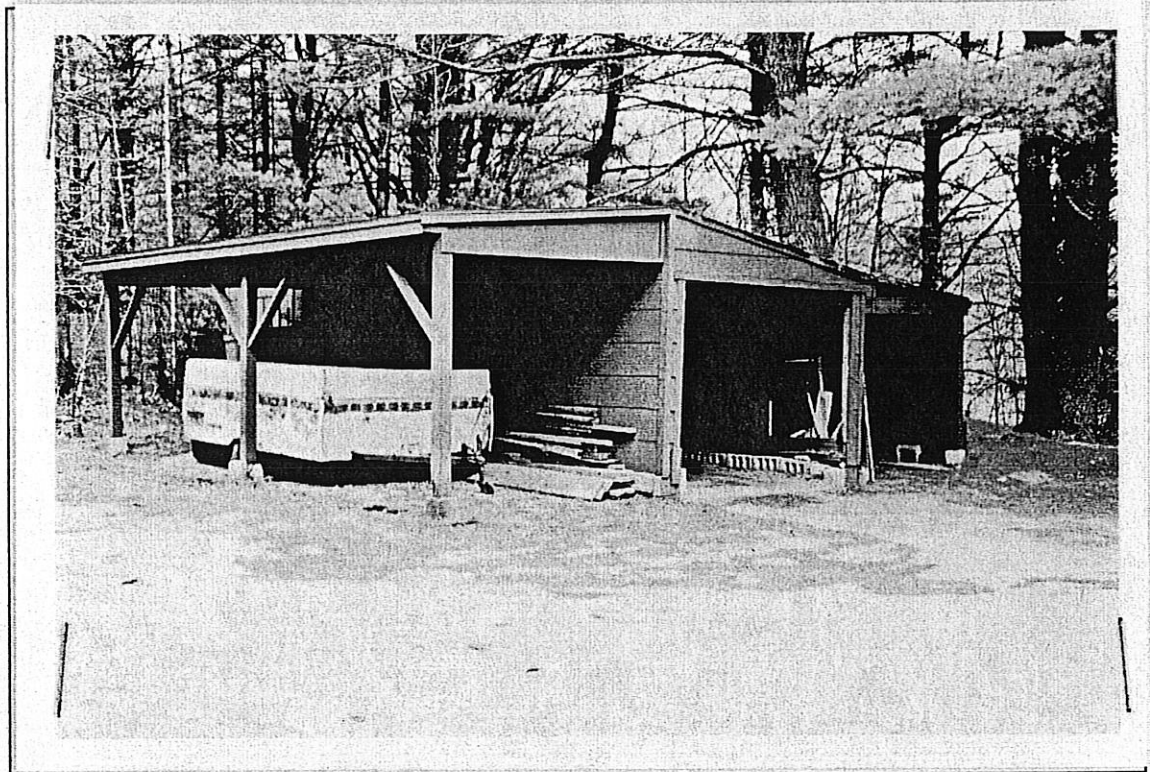


Photo 4 description: Shed to east of house

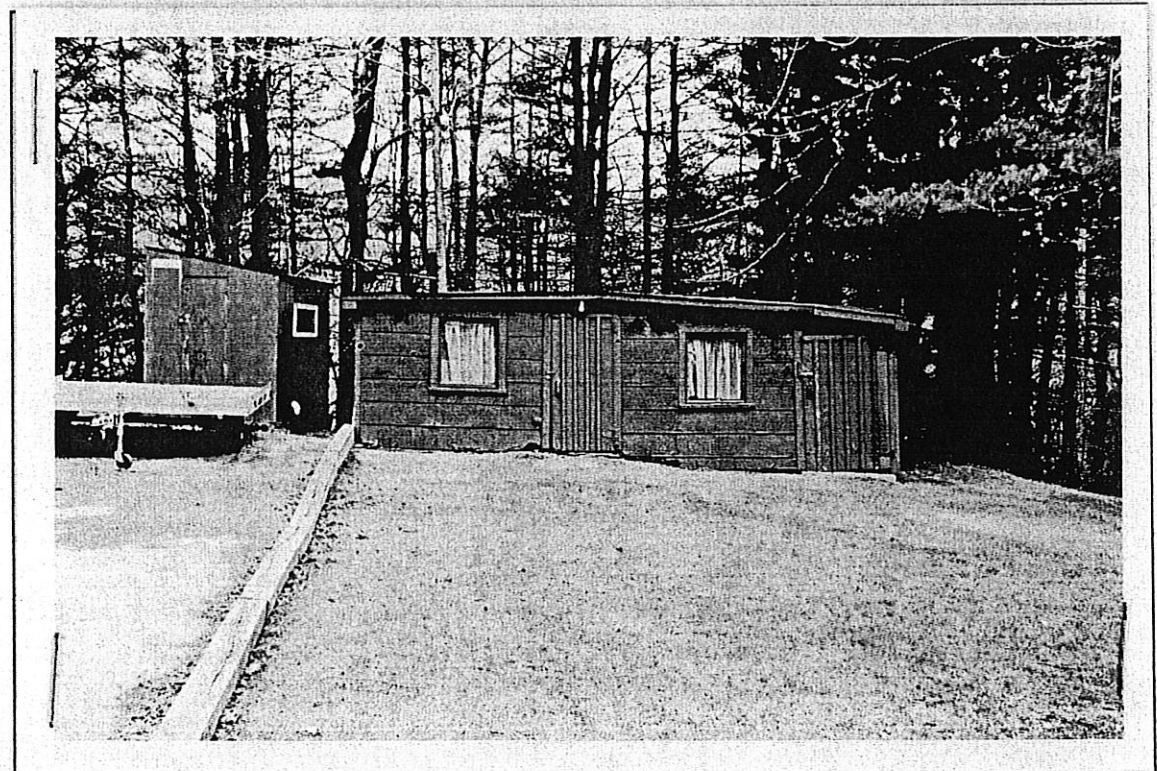


Photo 5 description: Sheds to southeast of house

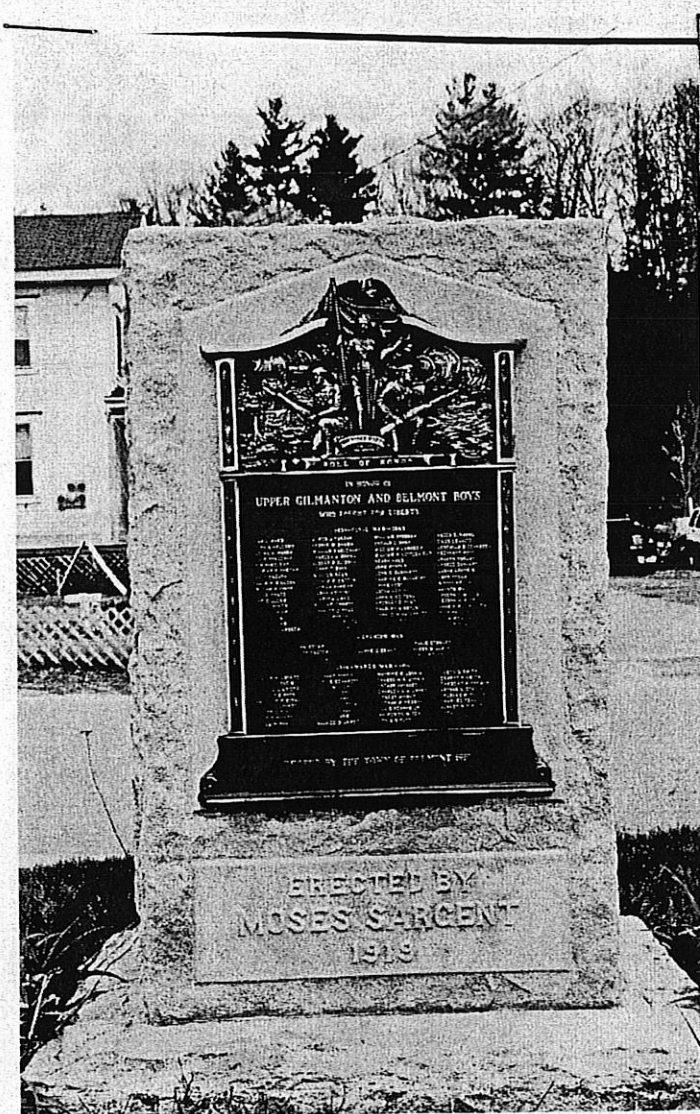

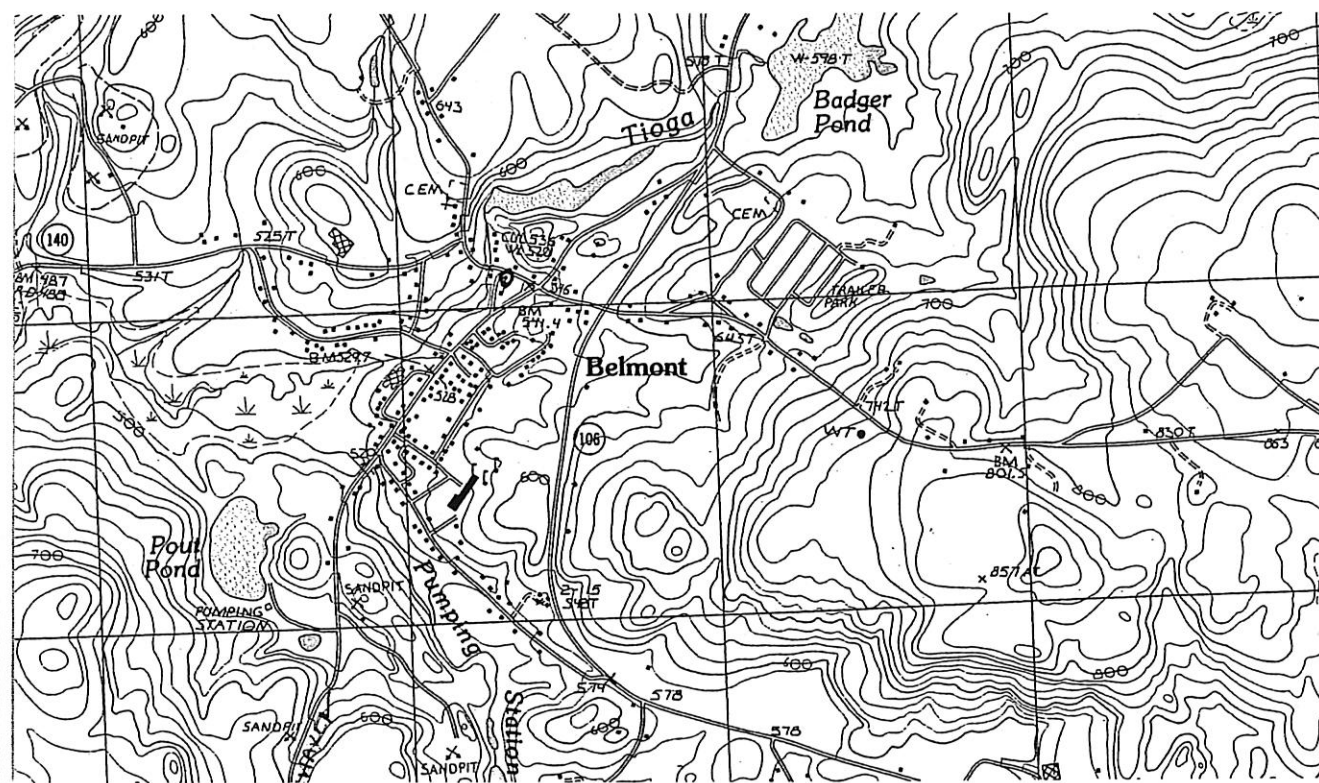

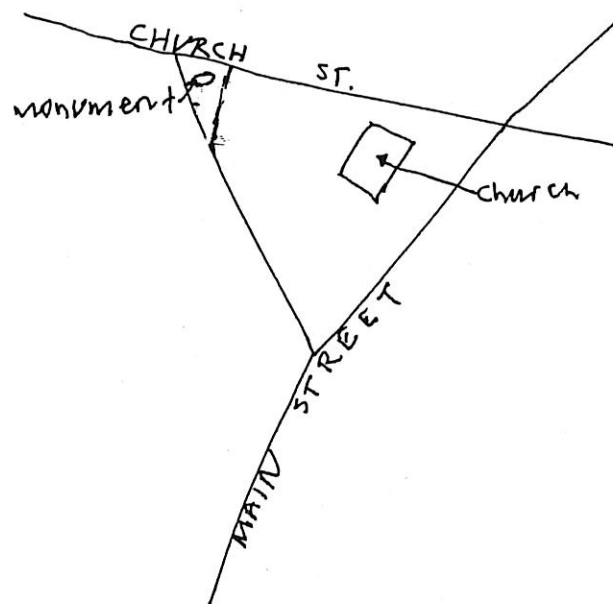

Additional Historical Information:

Moses Sargent, Jr. presented this monument to the town in 1919 in commemoration of its war veterans. It is a simple granite rectangular stone, mounted on a granite base, and flanked by iron lamp posts. The site, a small, grassy island, was previously occupied by a platform that served as a bandstand.

Two bronze plaques are mounted on the stone. On the south face is the original plaque, fashioned by Liberty Bronze Works of New York City, which depicts World War One armed soldiers and Liberty. Beneath are the names of those who fought in the Civil and Spanish wars and World War One. The plaque on the north face was mounted in 1966.

Sargent was the son of Moses Sargent Sr., who purchased the Belmont Mill in 1865 and converted it into a successful hosiery factory, effectively securing the village's position as a textile center. For some forty years, Moses Jr. managed the mill and oversaw major expansions. Active in civic affairs, he resided in the village until his death on May 1, 1922.

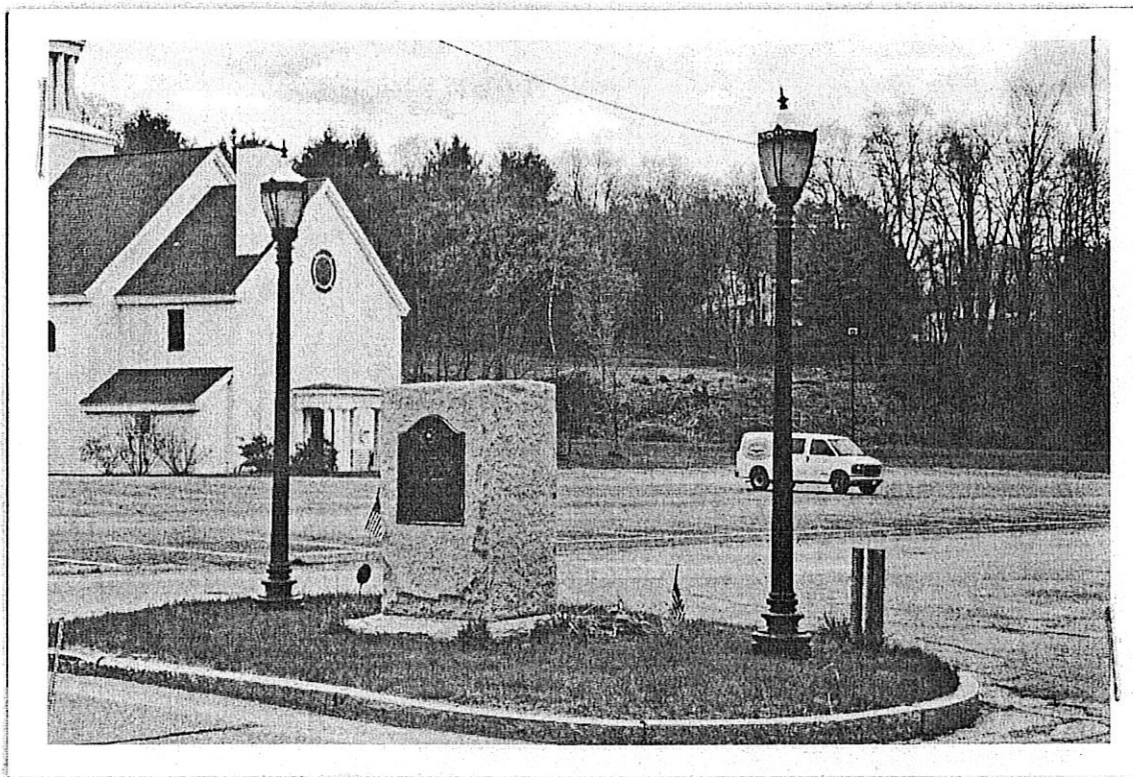


Photo 2 description: View of monument in setting

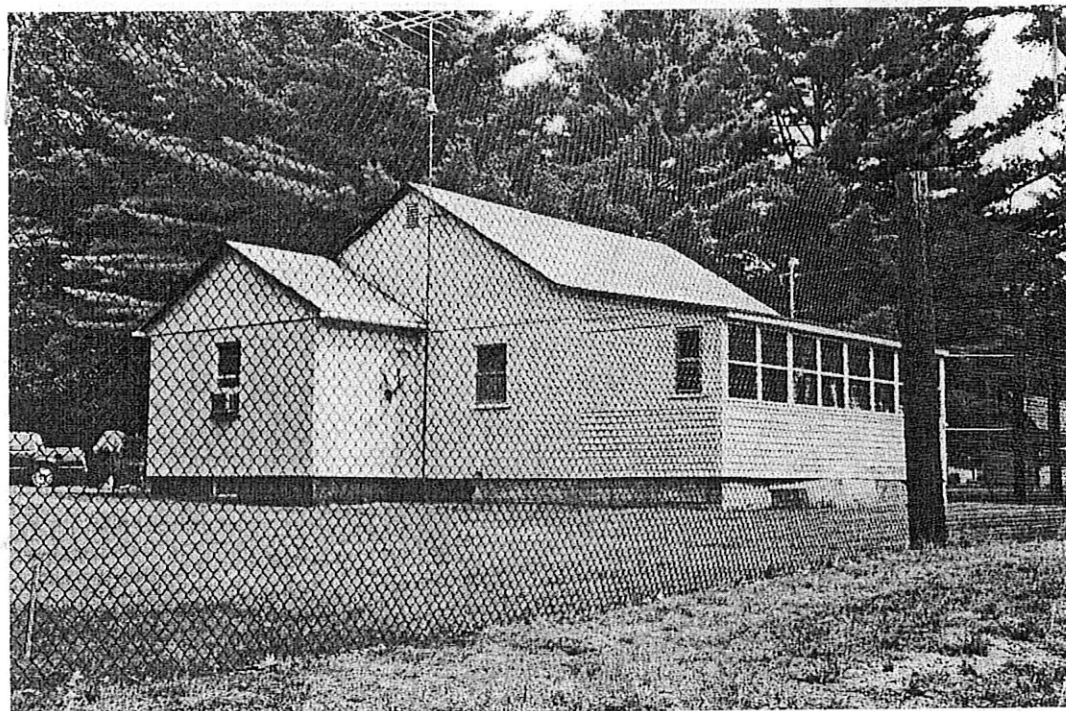


Photo 2 description: Facade & west elevation

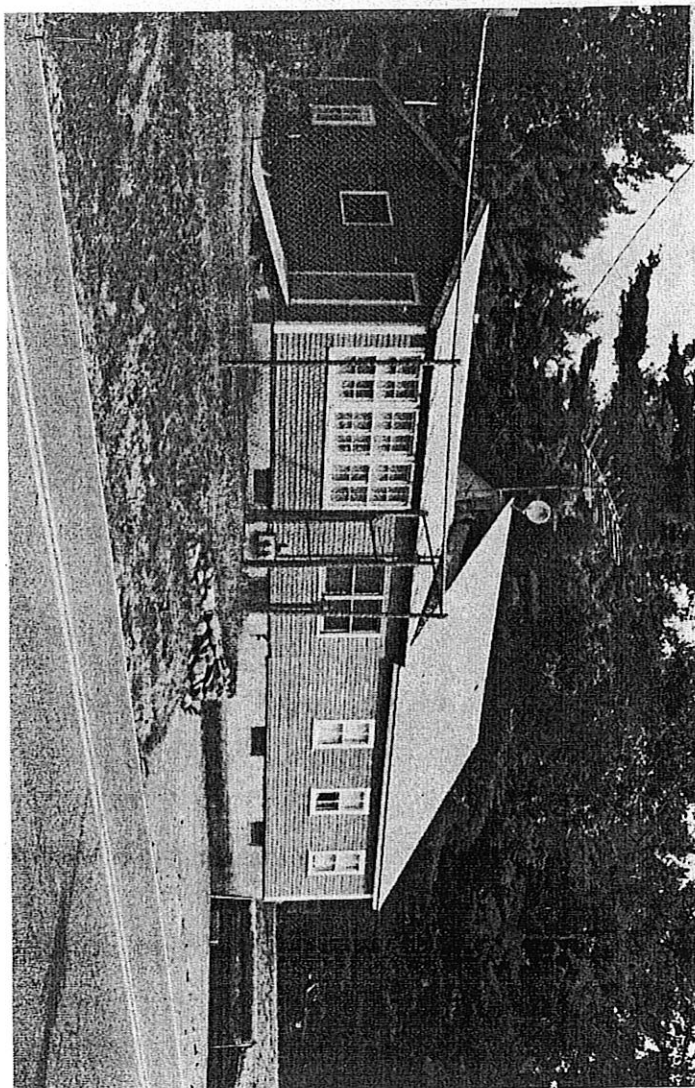
