

Hillary motioned to accept the reimbursement request for \$84 for the Ancestry renewal. Kyle seconded, all in favor.


The reimbursement request form has been signed by all voting members and Sharon will drop it off at town hall after the meeting.

Sharon is up for reelection this year. Fred Wells is running as well. Good Luck to our candidates!




