

Belmont Heritage Commission - July 21, 2022 Meeting Minutes

New Business:

- **B.** <u>Belmont High School Representative</u> members reviewed and accepted Adam Riberio's application and letter to become a non-voting member of the Heritage Commission during his Junior and Senior years.
- C. Penstock Update- Jack reported on his findings concerning Penstock.
- 1. Jack met with Land Use staff informing them of the cost and project's more important concerns.
- 2. Project is more encompassing than expected for the Heritage Commission but other ideas were suggested from Land Use on how to take care of certain areas.
- 3. Land Use appreciated information given from the Commission about location of other penstock pieces that would be helpful in knowing for future town or state highway projects.
- 4. Jack and hopefully Ben will meet again with Land Use staff in August.
- **D.** Old Home Day A quick review of what we will have for Old Home Day was discussed and what we need to bring.
