- 1) Chili must be warm, ready to serve in an electric roaster/crockpot and brought to the Tioga Pavilion by 10:45 am. Electricity will be provided.
- 2) Teams/Individuals must provide a minimum of 6 quarts of chili so everyone gets a taste.
- 3) Chili can consist of any type of meat, beans, vegetables or combination thereof. If you call it chili, we will call it chili. You must be willing to eat your own chili.
- 4) Bowls, utensils & napkins are provided. Please bring anything else you need.
- 5) Each chili will be judged on its own merit in one of the 4 categories:
 - Traditional
 - Vegetarian
 - Smokin' Hot
 - Most Savory
