
Hiking Kit


Enjoy the White Mountain trails with our help!

An informal conversation with a different topic/theme each week. A thoughtful, safe, and open discussion. Coffee included!


August's topics are: Three wishes from a genie, Title of your biography, Hobbies from the past, Nature vs. nurture




