Section 2 Containers

(A container is considered empty when no more than one inch or 3% [by weight] of material is left in the container, these can be disposed of in the regular trash)

Marine Flares

(Pyrotechnic flares cannot be accepted at the collection because they are categorized as explosives)

(Dispose of in the regular trash)

States Driveway Sealer (Genite)

(Solidify then dispose of in the regular trash)

• Medicine, Drugs, Needles & Syringes (Find safe and secure disposal near you)

O Propane Tanks

(Contact your local hardware store, propane swap location or propane provider for safe disposal)

Smoke Detectors
