

## 2024 Adult Summer Reading Instructions

Registration for Blackstone residents begins on Monday, June 10

Registration for non-residents begins on Monday, June 17

Patrons must have a Massachusetts Library Card in good standing to register for summer reading. Check-ins will take place once per week (weeks of July 1 and July 8 will count as one week). No multiple check-ins during a one-week period.

Each participant will receive:

1. Contract: The patron fills out the contract and a staff member signs the contract. Please make a copy. The patron receives the copy and the original contract goes into the summer reading binder (alphabetically by last name).
2. Library check-in log. This is on the back of the contract. When a patron comes to the desk with their reading log, please initial his/her reading log as well as transcribe their information into the check-in log in the binder. They may pick out a prize from the basket.
3. Reading Log: The patron takes this home for their own use. The patron will keep track of the hours he/she has read throughout the program. Audiobooks do count.
4. Program information packet with check-in requirements and event schedule.

Check-in requirements for programs are as follows:

Five check-ins in order to attend the Chocolate Party Finale

Two check-ins to attend Paint Night

Check-ins to attend all other craft sessions vary except for the craft on June 24.
