The board approved this action and in case the man does not return to do this we should have it done in the spring. An inquiry as to why the back door of the lirary is not available to the public led to some discussion on this matter. It was decided that a sidewalk should be placed from the center walk to the south driveway.

Merle Porter has offered the library some of his wood carvings. Sally Hagenbuch and Elsa Klenk were appointed to look into the matter and report at the next board meeting. Two books, <u>Creative Years</u> and <u>God is for Real. Man</u>, were selected from a list supplied by the donor in memory of Iva Grinage. The Past Presidents of the Service Club will donate <u>Gods Smuggler</u> in memory of Iva Grinage and <u>Merry Widow</u> in memory of Hazel Shepherd.

Helen Goble discussed the budget and in light of the Village Council granting the increase it was decided that the library will be open on Wednesdays from now on. Miss Gofff was confident that Alice and she could work out the hours so that she would only work five days. The decision as to how much nmoney be put in the certificate of deposit was left up to the disgretion of Helen Goble. Meeting was adjourned.
