Discussion on the budget for the coming year was held.


Discussion on washing the tables, chairs and desk of Miss Goff's was held. Pat Riley will get an estimate from Service Master.

The Secretary's report was read and approved. The Treasurer reported expenses of \$1,548.50 leaving a remaining budget of \$16,401.12.

Elsa Klenk read the estimate from Elden Draperies for auditorium drapes which consisted of the following: Black out curtain \$244.00; rod \$25.00; regular drapes \$410.00 for a total of \$679.00. Pat Riley made a motion, supported by Mary Jane McColl that we order these drapes. Motion carried.

The estimate from Service Master for washing chairs, tables and desk was \$470.50. Mary Case made a motion, supported by Pat Riley, that we do not accept this bid. Motion carried.

The revised bid of \$325.00 on the 15-drawer file card cabinet from Lynn Southward was received. The higher bid was due to an increase on the hardware of the cabinet. The bid was accepted.

Gretta Reinhardt reported that the Village Attorney had written a letter to Mr. and Mrs. David Seegert in an effort to have their daughter return the Library books. No reply was received. It was decided to have Miss Goff take the matter up with the Village Police to see if they might persuade the Seegert's to return the books.

Pat Riley reported that she had sent out 73 letters of thanks for gift money received.

Mary Case reported that the Rotary would like us to purchase 2 more tables for the auditorium. Mary Jane McColl made a motion, supported by Pat Riley, that we purchase 2 more tables, to match the ones recently purchased. Motion carried. Mary Case will take care of the purchasing.

Miss Goff reported a crack in one of the front windows. Elsa Klenk will contact Harold Jonas, who has our glass insurance, to see what can be done about replacing the glass.

Miss Goff also reported that our maintenance agreement on our copy machine was renewed for a year at \$135.00.

Elsa Klenk reported that the Village is working on the drain in the back room and estimate it will cost around \$100.00 to put in working order.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.

Mary Case reported that she had ordered two (2) more tables from Tagsolds for the auditorium.


Discussion on washing and waxing furniture was held. Elsa Klenk will see about getting someone to do this work.

Gretta Reinhardt made a motion, supported by Pat Riley, that we subscribe to the Library Journal for 1 year (published twice a month) for \$19.00; to renew our subscription for 1 year to Booklist for \$24.00 and to renew our subscription for 1 year to Kirkus for \$36.00. Motion carried.

New shelving was discussed and an estimate presented from Michigan School Service. A motion was made by Pat Riley, supported by Gretta Reinhardt, that we table the shelving until another estimate on exactly what we wish to purchase is presented. Motion carried.

Mark Slomski is shoveling the Library walks.


