
Language and Speech






Courses offered in mathematics ranged from general math to trigonometry. One year of math is required for graduation. The variety of courses offered help the students to plan for their life's work.











Coach Al Shaffer, the school, and the community can be proud of the success of this year's Blissfield Royals basketball team, which posted an enviable overall record of 13 wins and 6 losses; 11-3 league play, 0-2 in non-league games; and 2-1 in tournament action.

Blissfield displayed a nicely balanced offense all season and had the best defensive team, having the least-points-scoredagainst-them average in the league. In the home game against Grosse Ile the Royals set a scoring record for the new gymnasium of 81 points.

So now in closing, we want to thank all of you for coming, and again we welcome you. We only regret that we cannot say it again.









Seniors Visit Washington!


