The juniors took all honors when their masterpiece "Let's Lick 'Em" also won first prize in the float contest. Midnight arrived and Homecoming was over for another year.



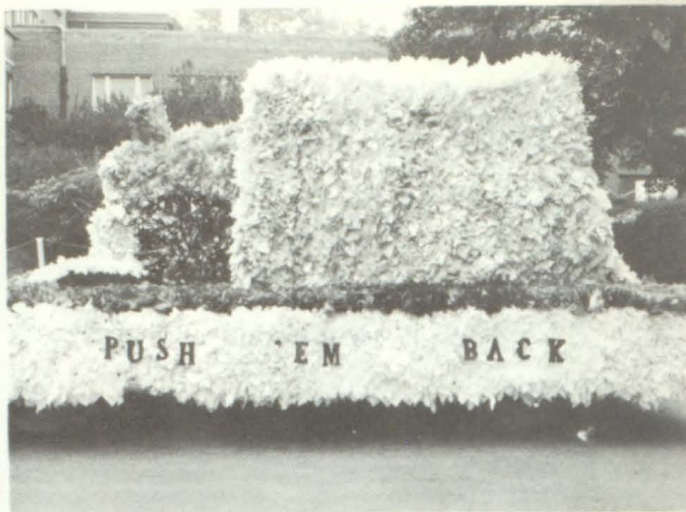

The plot featured Mr. and Mrs. Bennett and their struggle to find prospective husbands for their five daughters, all of marrying age.



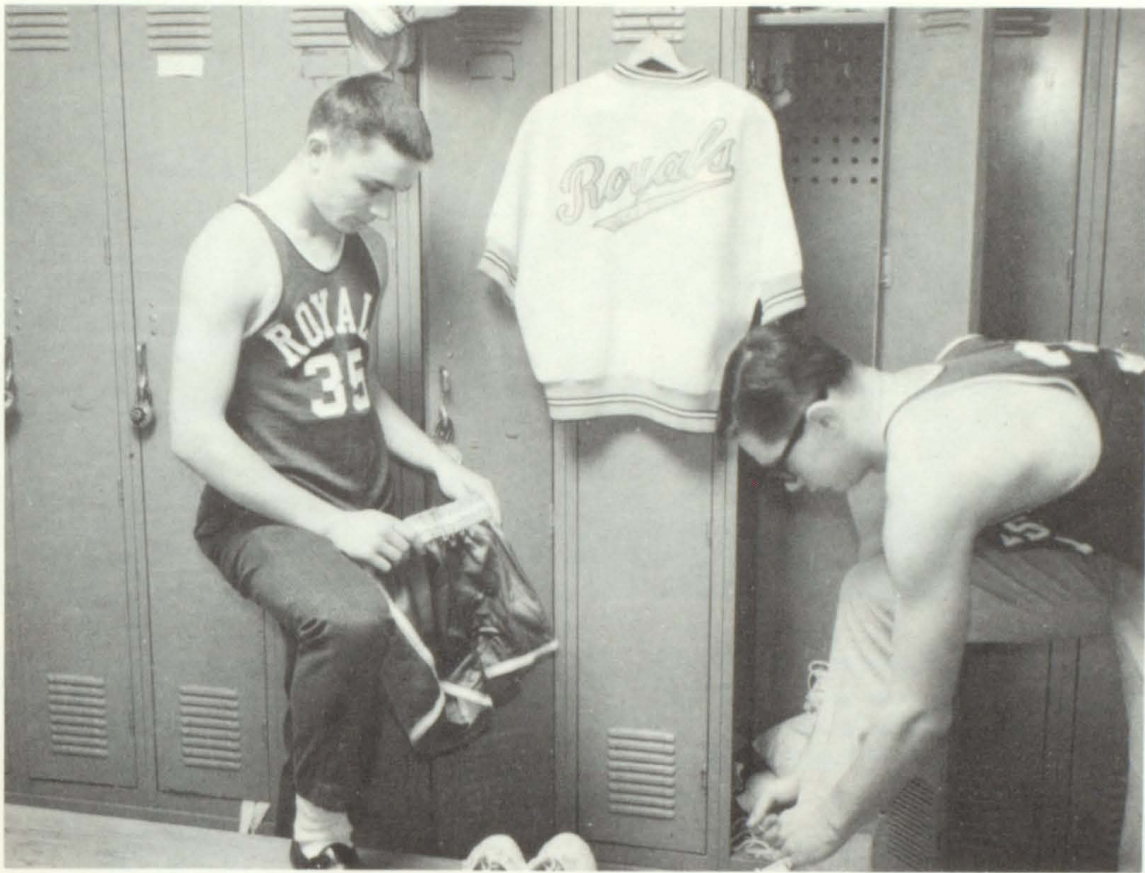

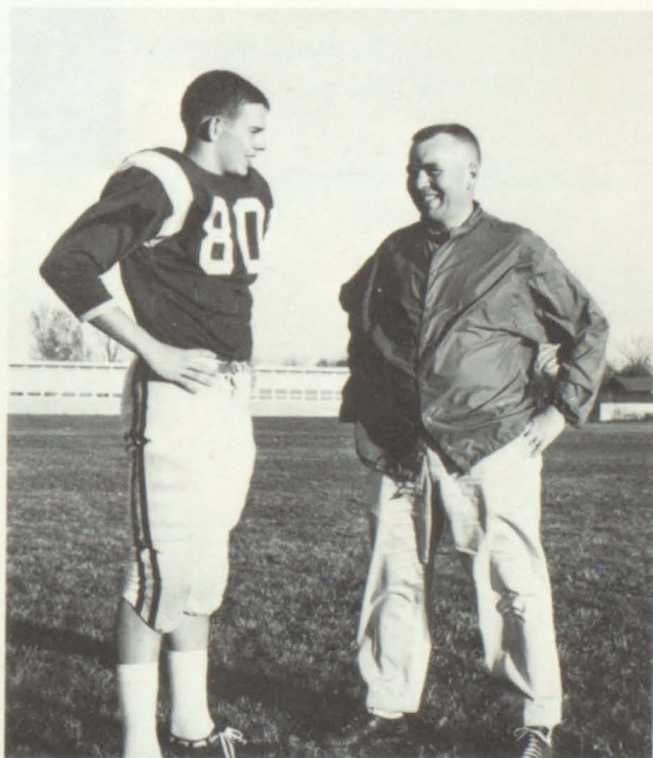

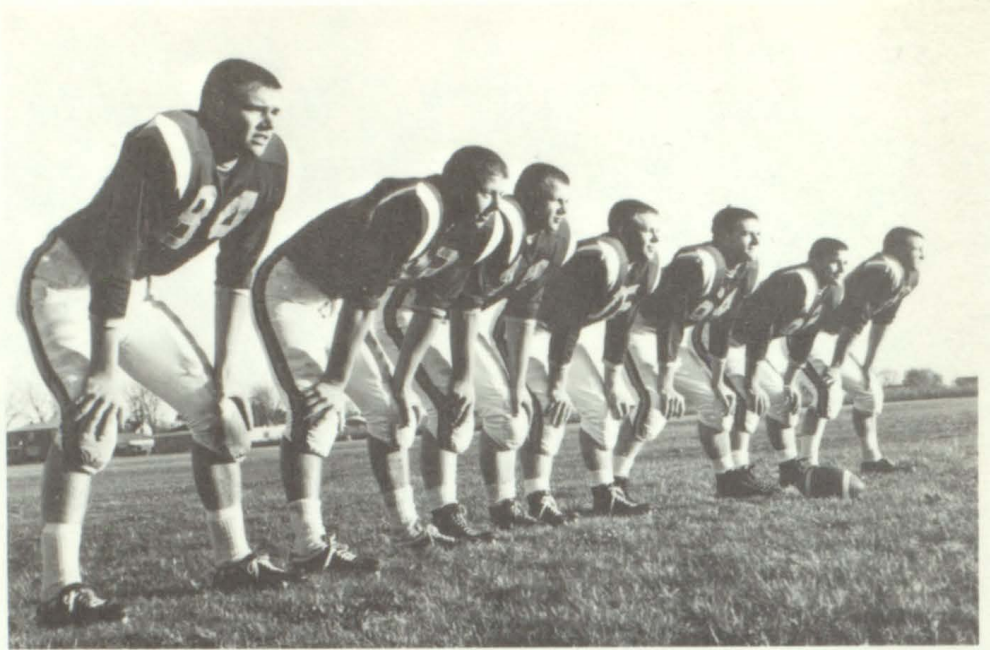
With the Huron League football championship in mind as a worthwhile goal ahead, the 1962-63 Royals started the season with grim determination and long hours of practice.
