

THE SCHULTZ-HOLMES MEMORIAL LIBRARY

Selling and Solicitation Policy

1. The library may sell items such as those items at book sales or convenience items for patrons. Any proceeds from the sales will be used to purchase new items for the library or to replenish the stock of convenience items.
2. The library will not sell items for individuals or groups when the financial benefit is intended for that individual or group.
3. Library patrons or employees may not solicit other library patrons on library property. As a public place, the library may serve as a meeting place for any legal purpose not restricted by other library policies, so while a legal transaction may not begin at the library, it may conclude there.
4. The library takes no responsibility as a “go-between” for any communication or transaction, financial or otherwise, outside of normal library business.
5. Performers and authors may be allowed to sell books or other related items at the library during the time of their scheduled programs.
6. This policy is not intended to restrict reasonable fundraising activities among library employees as long as those activities do not unreasonably interfere with library business or employee duties and responsibilities.
