


June 1-July 31 MiLibraryQuest: Summer

July 12-16 Washer Jewelry Take & Make Hardware never looked so good!




Select your materials at the library. Take them home to create necklaces and bracelets to wear or give! Sign up online starting July 6.

TRACK the the number of minutes that you read using Wandoo Reader, a mobile-friendly website, at https:// wandooreader.com/bridgmanlibrary/tails-tails-2021 or use the QR code. Every 60 minutes logged earns one entry into the grand prize drawing in August. If you have used Wandoo Reader before, please reuse your login. The library can help you reset your password. Paper logs are available upon request. NOTE: Parents can link family accounts by clicking the "Enter Family Management Portal" button. This allows you to add, register, and manage your whole family's accounts in one place. Each child will need an account, but you can easily log in to each account without entering each username and password


