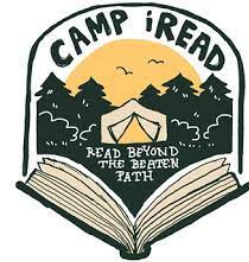

### Genealogy Group

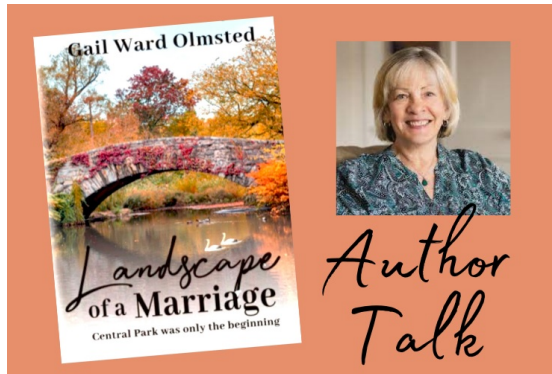

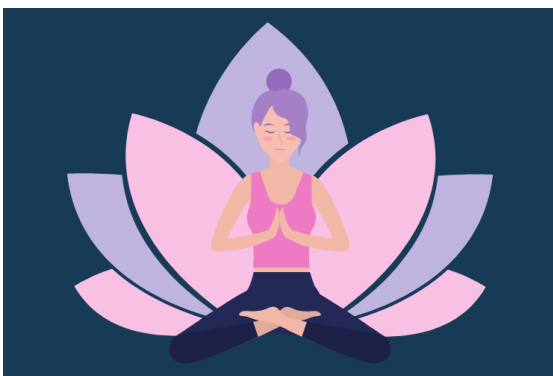

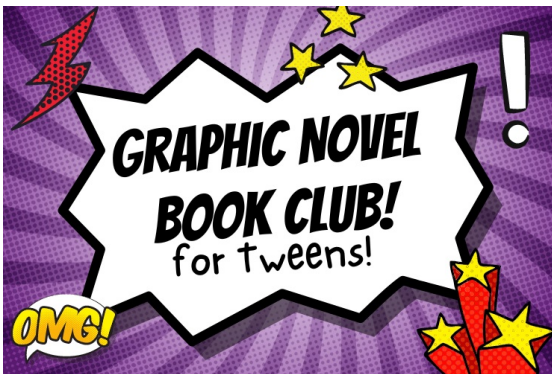
### Drop-In Lego Club
