

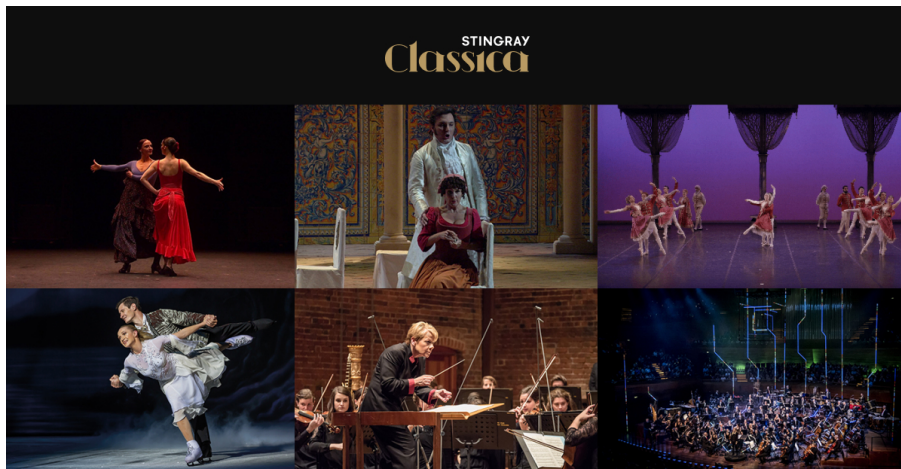

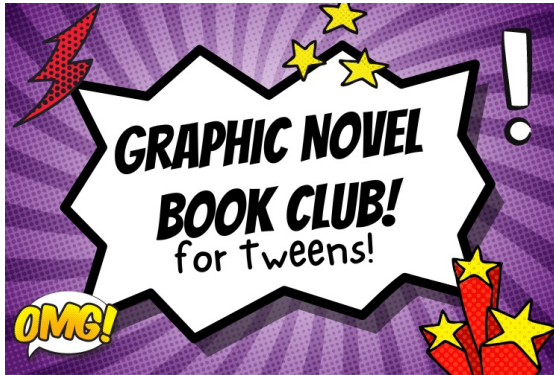


Drop-In Lego Club
