Membership

La Grande residents are eligible for free membership with full access if they reside within City limits. Union County residents are eligible for free membership with limited access.

Individuals must apply in person to receive a library card. Current photo I.D. and proof of address are required.

Residents of Elgin, North Powder, and Union may obtain a library card from their hometown library, or pay for a Cook Memorial Library membership for full access. A library card from any of the above libraries may be used at Cook Memorial Library with limited access.

Anyone, regardless of residential address may purchase a full access membership.

Loan Periods & Fees

- Loan periods range from 1 to 3 weeks
- Two autorenewals per item, unless item is on hold for another patron
- No late fees
- Patrons are financially responsible for lost or damaged items
- Unreturned items are turned over to collections 4 weeks after each item's final due date (after all renewals have been used)
- Library card replacement fee is \$1
