- **TINY TOT STORY TIME**

Geared toward children ages 0-5. Come enjoy music, finger plays, dancing, a book, and cooperative play. This is a great program for little children and their caregiver.

- **MUMS- MOMS UPLIFTING MOMS**

Mums is where Moms uplift one another, discuss important topics, chat with other moms in our community, and let our children play while we all get the social time we need. This is intended for moms and their children ages 0-5.

- **PRE-SCHOOL STORY**

Geared toward children ages 0-5. Come enjoy music, dancing, a book, and a craft. This program is for children and their caregiver.

- **PRE-SCHOOL STORY TIME WITH SPECIAL GUEST FROM FRIENDS OF THE VERDE RIVER**

On September 28th The Friends of the Verde River will be coming to share their new book. We will also be doing a fun river craft.

- **ZUMBINI**

This program uses the power of music and movement to promote cognitive, social, emotional, and motor skill development for children age 0-5 and their caregivers. The program may extend to noon if needed.

- **PAWS TO READ**

Children 6 and up can sign up to read to a therapy dog. This helps build confidence in reading. Registration required.

- **CARTOONING FOR KIDS**

Kids and teens from ages 7-18 can come and learn how to draw from The Janimal, a real cartoon artist!

- **FAMILY CRAFT**

Children of all ages and their caregivers are invited to come listen to a book and do a related craft.

- **CODING CLUB**

Kids ages 11-18 can come learn to code using Scratch. Registration required.

- **YES I CAN**

Children ages 8-12 are welcome to come and learn social emotional skills through games and hands-on activities

- **THINGS THAT EXPLODE**

Kids ages 8-12 assist with science experiments

- **POKEMON HANGOUT**

Kids ages 6-12 can hangout with friends while discussing pokemon. Kids will also play Pokemon games and activities.

- **TWEEN VR**

Kids ages 8-12 can try out virtual reality! First come first served, children take turns with the devices.

- **COOKIES AND COMPLAINING TWEEN**

Eat cookies and complain! Ages 8-12

Teens ages 13-18 can come play DnD with friends. Registration required.

- **FRIYAY GAME NIGHT**
