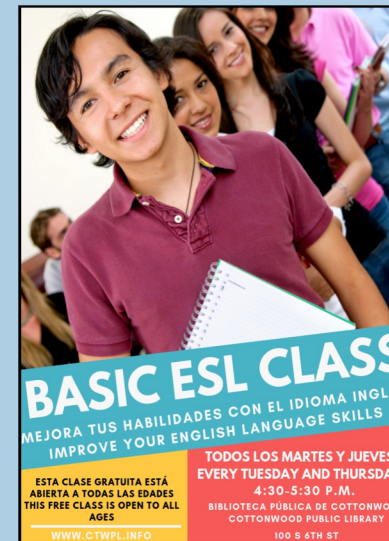

Welcome to Cottonwood Public Library.

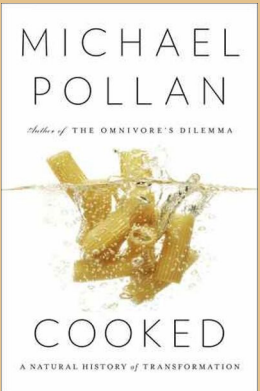
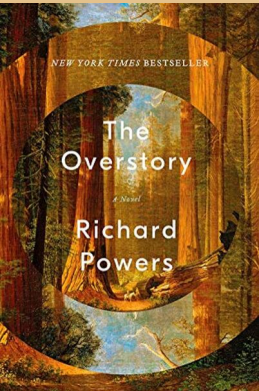
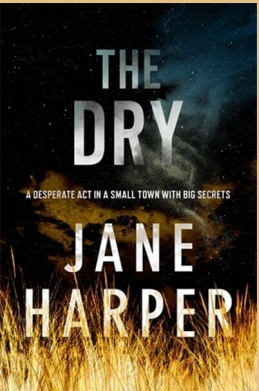
