

The learning curve for me coming from Parks and Recreation to the library has often felt very steep. You can observe from afar and research the job, but inevitably, there are aspects you have to learn on the job. One of my most pleasant surprises and there have been many, are the Bookmarks - Friends of the Cottonwood Public Library.

What are the Bookmarks, and what do they do? To me, this is the fundraising arm of the library. They operate under the 501 c (3) status with the sole purpose of using the money obtained to benefit the Cottonwood Public Library. A fantastic concept that our library has been using to our advantage since 1971.

The Bookmarks can utilize a variety of avenues to raise these monies. The bread and butter of the operation are book sales from the Boutique. Yes, all of those books across from the Reference Desk are for sale, and the proceeds directly benefit the library. And as a Bookmarks member, all of those books can be purchased for 1/2 price. They are also actively selling books online.

And it is a small group of volunteers that make all of this happen. Feb. 1 is the annual Bookmarks meeting, with yearly updates, and board member voting. Feb. 1 also marked the last day for Louise Appleton to act as Chair. I want to thank her for her two-plus years of service to the Bookmarks, our library, and the community. I know the work she put into the Bookmarks, and we are all benefiting from the fruits of her labor. I would also like to thank Gail Smith and her "crew" for all of the work they do operating the Boutique. A small group of people moves a lot of books week after week so that our library can be what it is today.

Thank you to all of the Bookmarks board members, membership, and frequent users for supporting library programs, additional materials, staff training, a high school scholarship, and much, much more to come. 






Harriet is a 2019 American biographical film about slave-turned-abolitionist Harriet Tubman. Directed by Kasi Lemmons, who wrote the screenplay with Gregory Allen Howard, it stars Cynthia Erivo as Tubman, with Leslie Odom Jr., Joe Alwyn, and Janelle Monáe in supporting roles. Harriet had its world premiere at the Toronto International Film Festival on September 10, 2019, and was theatrically released in the United States on November 1, 2019, by Focus Features. It received generally favorable reviews from critics, who praised Erivo's performance and found the film sincere but formulaic. For her performance in the film, Erivo received nominations at the Academy Awards, Golden Globes and the Screen Actors Guild, as well as an Oscar nomination for Best Original Song ("Stand Up").






#### **In-Person Homework Help Is Now Available!**






