Book Spine Bookmarks Supply List & Instructions

Supplies (per bookmark):

- 1. 1 discarded hardcover book
- 2. 1 piece of cardstock or fabric, in any color or pattern you wish (size of the book spine or slightly larger)
- 3. A ruler
- 4. Sharp scissors or exacto knife
- 5. Super sticky quick-dry or fabric glue
- 6. Single hole or grommet punch
- 7. Length of ribbon appx. 6-8 inches in length

Instructions:

- Using the scissors or exacto knife, separate the cover (including spine) of the books from the bound signatures.
- 2. Lay the book cover flat and cut the spine away from the front and rear boards of the book. *Tip: Cut as close to the boards as possible to keep as much material as you can on either side of the spine for trimming.
- 3. Trim the spine and scrape off any glue or binding residue.
- 4. Using the spine as your template, trace the shape of the spine onto the piece of cardstock or fabric.
- 5. Cut the cardstock/fabric shape out and trim to fit neatly covering the back of the book spine.
- 6. Glue the two pieces together and either fold the edges of the spine over the cardstock or trim for a clean edge.
- 7. Use the hole punch at the top center of the bookmark.

- 8. Fold the ribbon in half, feeding the fold in the center through the punched hole.
- 9. Bring the ends of the ribbon through the loop this feed creates and pull tight!
- 10. Decorate further as you wish and enjoy!
