Re: Director's Report

- 1. Programming Information: ETCSD's elementary schools celebrated Reading Comes Alive Week beginning March 4<sup>th</sup>. Included in that celebration is their 2<sup>nd</sup> Community Read. We added a link to information and daily videos to our website. In addition, we are partnering with the elementary art teacher and the 4<sup>th</sup> grade classes to sponsor a bookmark design competition for this year's Summer Reading Program theme: Adventure Begins at Your Library. Monday programs for the SRP are largely booked. PLLS is providing four of the programs. The other three will include the traditional rocket program and likely the FFA petting zoo as well as the pizza party. The Early Childhood Education class at the high school has ended so the library staff will now be supervising our Preschool Play Group.
- 2. Staff Activity: We held interviews for the children's librarian position. There were five candidates. We interviewed four as one contacted me in advance stating she needs to focus on graduate school right now.
- **3. Building Update:** Mike Zei stopped in to see the lower level and work out a painting plan. The Trustee Essentials chapter on accessibility highlighted our lack of signage. I ordered an Accessible Entrance sign for the side entrance.
- 4. Misc: No real updates on the Strategic Plan as we meet next on March 14<sup>th</sup> to review data from the community survey. Steve Ohs scheduled a meeting with Walworth County library directors to go over the Walworth County Plan of Service on March 8<sup>th</sup>.
