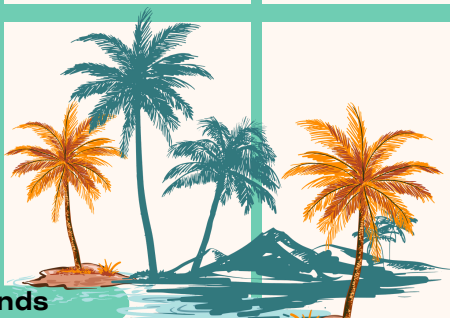

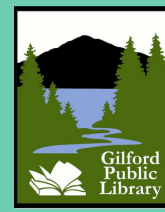

SENIOR NUTRITION - JUNE 19 @ 10AM

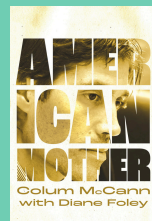
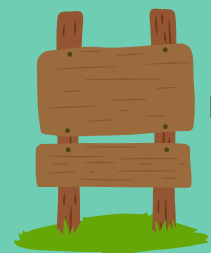

FILM CLASSICS: ICONIC MOVIE SCENES - JUNE 24 @ 5:30PM

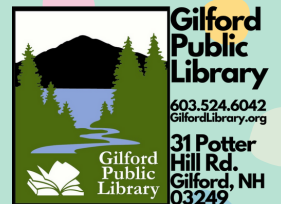
Author and pop culture historian, Marty Gitlin, talks about what made certain film scenes so iconic along with playing some classic movie trivia.
