## **Discussed:**

1. Dec Minutes – Approved as amended (Balance updated)
2. Treasurer's report
  - a. Current balance: \$35,070.06
  - b. The Friends received \$5.64 from Amazon Smile.
  - c. Alisha got a debit card to make purchases easier.
  - d. Alisha will check Citizens for CD rates and Money Market rates.
3. Director's Report (Joanna Meighan)
  - a. Finished cookbook sale and made over \$800.
  - b. "Take Your Child to the Library Day"
    - i. Date: Saturday, February 4
    - ii. Want to encourage people to come into the library as families.
    - iii. There will be Legos and games for kids.
    - iv. Refreshments: Alisha and Deborah will bake; Jean and Melodee will provide drinks.
    - v. Door prizes: Joanna requested one \$25 for each of these local merchants: Nicks, Martha's and Applecrest. This was approved. Alisha will pick these up.
  - c. Scott Faiia presentation on Ethiopia -- Wednesday, February 8
    - i. Refreshments: Donna and Judy will bake for this event.
  - d. Museum Gift Cards
    - i. Discussion included museums such as McAuliffe-Shepard Discovery Center, Boston Children's Museum, Museum of Science, and the New England Aquarium.
    - ii. Had trouble finding ways to buy gift cards at some of these places.
    - iii. [Aquarium](#) had gift cards available. Joanna and Leah requested 4 \$50 gift cards for a total of \$200. Each gift card would cover 2 children's fees. This was approved with shipping costs. Alisha will call to purchase to hopefully reduce the total shipping cost fee. Online it is \$9.99 per card because cards have to be ordered separately.
4. STEM Discover Kits
  - a. Leah has short list; total retail is around \$310.
    - i. Chemistry Kit (Flux Game, Molecule Set, Basher Science, Elements Book): \$93.91
    - ii. Laser Kit (Laser Maze, Book): \$55.98
    - iii. Microscope Kit (Microscope, Prepared Slides, Book): \$109.95
    - iv. US Kit (Scrambled States Game and Book, Puzzle, United Tweets Book): \$54.96
    - v. A total of \$400 was approved to cover kits, shipping and bins for the kits to be stored.
5. Adults Kits
  - a. Trustees brought up the idea of kits for adults. Some ideas are below.
