

## Children's Room News

The Holyoke Public Library has teamed up with the University of Massachusetts' Italian Studies Department to offer the public of Holyoke free Italian language lessons.

Learners of all ages are invited to attend lessons every Monday from 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM. The Italian instructors are upper level undergraduate students who, under the supervision of their professor, teach a multileveled activity session.

New learners can <u>learn basic vocabulary</u>, <u>play bingo with Italian words</u>, <u>listen to Italian music and sing along</u>, as well as get a better understanding of Italian culture. There is also an advanced group which meets at the same time to practice their conversation skills. Some native speakers attend the course to assist in the finer points of pronunciation and this provides an additional resource for patrons to utilize.

Patrons of all ages may participate in either group based on how they feel about their proficiency. Some of the younger patrons may take to the language rather quickly, especially if they are already familiar with Spanish.

Children can learn foreign languages more quickly than adults. The reason for this is that the Broca's area of the brain is extremely active when a person is still a child. This area, when not put to use becomes underdeveloped, making it more difficult for people to learn a foreign language the older they get. It is for this reason, that children should be encouraged to learn a foreign language when they are young and their brain is continuing to grow.

# Teen Room News

The Teen Room has many activities on going and planned for Spring. Including, **Garden Girls**, an 8 week outdoor education series for girls ages 13-17, kicked off at the library on April 4th. The group will be planting public gardens and fruit trees throughout Holyoke, and learning about the natural world around them.

The **Teen Advisory Group** (**T.A.G.**), held its first meeting over the winter. The group will be helping plan youth led library programs for other teenagers in the Holyoke community. The group is currently in the process of planning a "late night at the library" event, where the library will be open after hours during an upcoming Friday. At this event teens will have the opportunity to watch a movie, eat pizza and snacks, play games, and sing karaoke, and dance.
