## **HUBBARDSTON PUBLIC LIBRARY SCHOLARSHIP**

### **AWARD PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

The Hubbardston Public Library will award two Hubbardston residents who have been accepted or who are continuing their education in an undergraduate, graduate, trade, or technical school program. This can be either on-campus or on-line. The scholarships each valued at \$500 may be used to pay for expenses for their continued education.

The applicant must complete, sign/verify, and submit the application form along with the 250-to-500 word personal essay by **June 30, 2024** for consideration. Proof of acceptance to a post-secondary educational program may be provided before the award will be finalized.

Hubbardston Library Trustees will evaluate each application based on all required information. Applicants may also be asked for a personal interview by the Trustees. All applicants will be contacted by a member of the Hubbardston Public Library Trustees by **August 30, 2024**.

Additionally applicants may submit an electronic scholarship form obtained from the HPL website.
