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Challenges: Hours, location, traffic, bridges, getting services to the people, accessibility, space inside and outside (comfort, accommodate, utilization), Online and technology-connection, how to connect and enhance, HVAC-to make more comfortable, parking, transportation

The How: Partnerships with schools and other departments, COMMUNICATION, Marketing-team efforts, website, social media; need to be less dependent on the Friends of the Library for money for programming; Quality versus Quantity; amplifying the library as the center of the village

Next steps: Liz will get the draft to us and public comments will be accepted from September 6 until September 14 or perhaps 21. K. Prodouz and I. Finn will present to the select board on September 5. Potential meetings for Trustees on September 14 and 21 to add input.

100th Anniversary of the library building (2024): brainstorming ideas thus far: I. Finn would like a Sunday event/open house. K. Prodouz suggested a cooperative event with Trustees and Friends on a theme of the library as the center of the village. C. Cunningham, K. Fox-Alfano and K. Prodouz are willing to work on planning.
