OLD BUSINESS

Book Sorting Committee: lots of book donations are coming in, most in great shape, but some without barcodes (cannot be resold through Kevin). These will go into the general book sales. Donna reported she secured a donation of 60 historical military paperback books via Facebook (Three Towns One Community) which will go to Operation Paperback (for US military bases around the world). A letter from a staff sergeant was received recently thanking KFL for book donations.

Action: Allison will email Kevin to pick up boxes sorted by committee for sale.

2024 Membership Drive mailing went out—27 memberships have come back so far (2023 ended with membership of 64).

NEW BUSINESS

Winter pop-up sale: Donna and Peg will coordinate with Michelle for a sale at end of January/start of February. All paperbacks, kept in boxes.

Library Updates: Michelle reported the **new strategic plan** is in the information gathering stage, including a public survey (end of January); public and targeted focus groups; and interviews. Risa will assist in leading some groups. One Fletcher Street will figure in discussions. Lawyers are assisting in planning options, especially regarding the residential rentals.

Programs are going strong—January 27 is Fashions of Jane Austin event. Allison noted they are working to build KFL's "Library of Things" to borrow (not books). She also noted that patrons like the "exchanges" such as gift wrapping, seed starting, etc.

Anita reported that the winter fundraising goal (\$35,000) was met successfully, and thanked Friends for assisting with mailing, donating, volunteering. As of today, over \$41,000 has been raised.

New tables are coming (Huston and Co!) and more electric outlets installed with *Room at Work and Libraries* grant money received.

OTHER

Michelle will investigate after-hour use of some One Fletcher parking spots.

Storybook ornaments are down and boxed. Donna will check the Friends closet for more acid free tissue paper supply. A suggestion was made to alert patrons to the tree being up in December, including families with children. Perhaps a story time with the ornaments or near the tree? Display some ornaments in the children's room?

A big thank you to staffer **Brittany** for repairing some of the ornaments—they look like new!

Empty banker boxes from book donations are piling up—**Michelle** will make them available to patrons.
