KFL Readies for Minerva Conversion; Closed Mon-Wed, June 9-11




KFL is on target to "go live" on **June 17** to join the Minerva consortium of Maine libraries. The <u>Minerva catalog</u> will provide our patrons with expanded access to over sixty public, academic, and private library

collections. The catalog includes over six million items; not only books but also DVDs, audiobooks, magazines, and music CDs. With this new system, patrons may request almost any item from the Minerva libraries' collection, and it will be delivered to the KFL for pick up.

The Library will be closed June 9, 10, and 11 (Mon., Tues., & Wed.) for staff training and for the conversion of over 40,000 records of items in our collection. We apologize for any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding.

On **June 12**, we will begin our "Library Card Drive" to issue new library cards to all of our patrons. We will also be offering training to our patrons on how to use the new catalog. season on Sat. June 28 from 8:30 AM to 1 PM. As always, there will be a lot to choose from. This sale includes many beautiful art books, as well as books about dogs, handicrafts and many cookbooks. See you there!

Volunteers Needed For Minerva Re-Barcoding


We need your help to re-barcode our books, DVDs, music and audio CDs--in other words--our collection! We've already started,

The IB Organization aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young

people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect. IB Visual Art is part of a rigorous curriculum and diploma program recognized by universities around the world. At KHS, IB Visual Art offers a unique, two-year course for those motivated students who are seriously committed to making and researching art.

AP Studio Art is an honors level course for high school Juniors and Seniors who from September to May build a portfolio of approximately 24 artworks. Students spend an entire year of



immersion in art making, delving deep into the creative process to make original, inventive and technically superior works of art.
