**AYERS-COTTON
 ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICE AWARD**

DESCRIPTION

In 2022, The Kim Ayers Award was renamed the *Ayers-Cotton Environmental Services Award* in honor of two prestigious individuals who served as beacons of their communities. Originally created in 1988 in memory of B. Kimball Ayers, Jr. of Moultonborough who significantly contributed to the Lakes Region environment for so many years, this honor will also be bestowed on the recently retired Commissioner and long-term Executive Board member John E. Cotton of Andover as a living icon of common sense environmental protection in the Lakes Region. Individuals considered for this award will have faithfully and persistently worked to maintain and improve the environmental quality of the Lakes Region in New Hampshire as both Kim Ayers and John Cotton have done.

QUALIFICATIONS

The recipient should be a person who lives in and has made a major voluntary contribution to the environmental quality of the Lakes Region. Particular considerations include, but are not limited to: environmental education; a key role initiating and carrying through an on-going project; emphasis on water quality; and intergovernmental cooperation (i.e., coordination between municipalities or between state and local governments).
